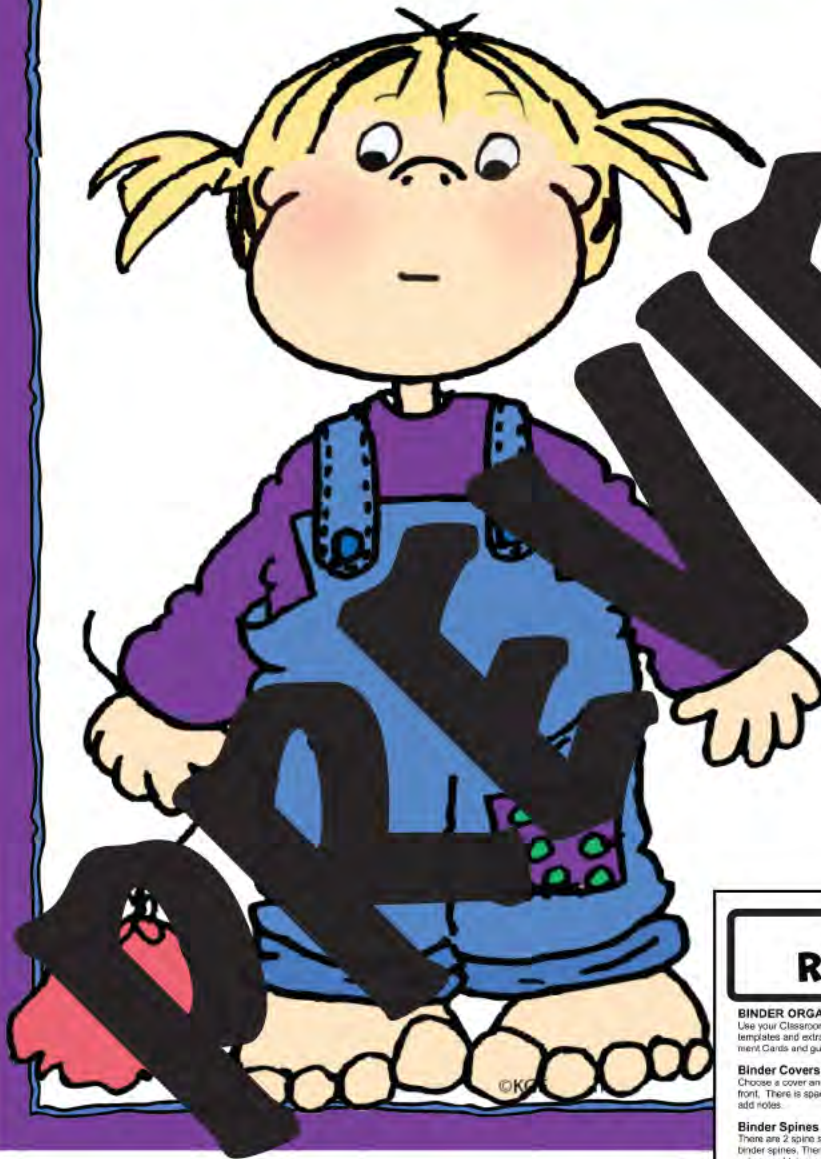

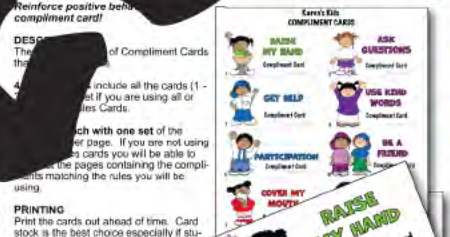

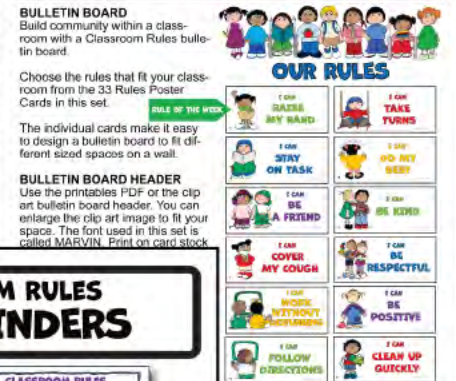

Classroom Rules Binder covers, spines and tabs will help to keep your materials organized. Choose a format (bright borders or white background) that matches your classroom colors and theme. COLORFUL RULES POSTER CARDS

There are 11 pages of Rules Poster Cards with 11 cards per page. Bright Borders and Plain Backgrounds (arranged on 11 x 8 1/2 inch pages and 8 1/2 x 11 inch pages). Cutting lines make it easy to cut the posters. There are plenty of cards to choose from. Use the ones you like.

WHY ARE THE CARDS NUMBERED?

Each rule has a unique number. Each poster card includes its rule number. The Compliment Cards match the poster cards and include the rule number in the bottom left corner. The Student Self-Check form has a list of all the numbered rules. The numbers make it easy for students and teachers to find the rules and the matching materials.

STUDENT SELF-CHECK FORMS

Student Self-Check forms allow students the ability to choose a rule-goal to work on for the week/month. In the speech bubble they use words or pictures to SHOW the rule. In the box they write or draw things they can do to help accomplish their goal. Students evaluate and rate their own achievement using a positive Rating Scale:

0 = keep working on it

3 = good but I want to do better

5 = accomplished my goal.

Students rate the previous accomplishment and identify a new goal.

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RULES POSTER CHART

The Rules poster can be posted in the bulletin board area and/or enlarged to hang in the classroom behind the goal and/or to post to students as a reference and stored in the personal Classroom Rules folder.

BINDER ORGANIZATION

Use your Classroom Rules binder to store all materials and extra Poster and Compliment Cards for guidelines.

Binder cover: Choose a cover to clip to your binder front.

Binder spine: Binder spines include images that match the images on each of the covers. There are 2 spine sizes for 1 1/2 inch binders and 2 inch binders.

CLASSROOM RULES RULES POSTER CARDS

Rules Poster Cards

There are 33 rules cards, 3 cards per 8 1/2 x 11 inch page. Laminate the cards (if possible) before cutting them out.

Formats

Two sets are included so you can use the set that matches your classroom colors and themes. Choose between the bright border cards or cards without borders.

Organizing the Poster Cards

If you are not using all of the 33 cards at one time you can store extras in the Organizing Binder. They will be ready if you need them.

Numbers

The small number in the bottom left corner of the card is the card number. The card numbers are listed on the Organizing Binder. Cards are numbered to help you find the card for individual students or the entire class.



CLASSROOM RULES COMPLIMENT CARDS

Reinforce positive behaviors with a compliment card!

DESCRIPTION

There are 37 pages of Compliment Cards that match each rule.

4 variety-pages include all the cards (1 - 33). Print this set if you are using all or most of the Rules Cards.

33 pages, each with one set of the same rules per page. If you are not using all of the rules cards you will be able to print just the pages containing the compliments matching the rules you will be using.

PRINTING

Print the cards out ahead of time. Card stock is the best choice especially if students are collecting them. The cards can be punched a hole so they can be collected by students and stored in a metal ring.

ORGANIZATION

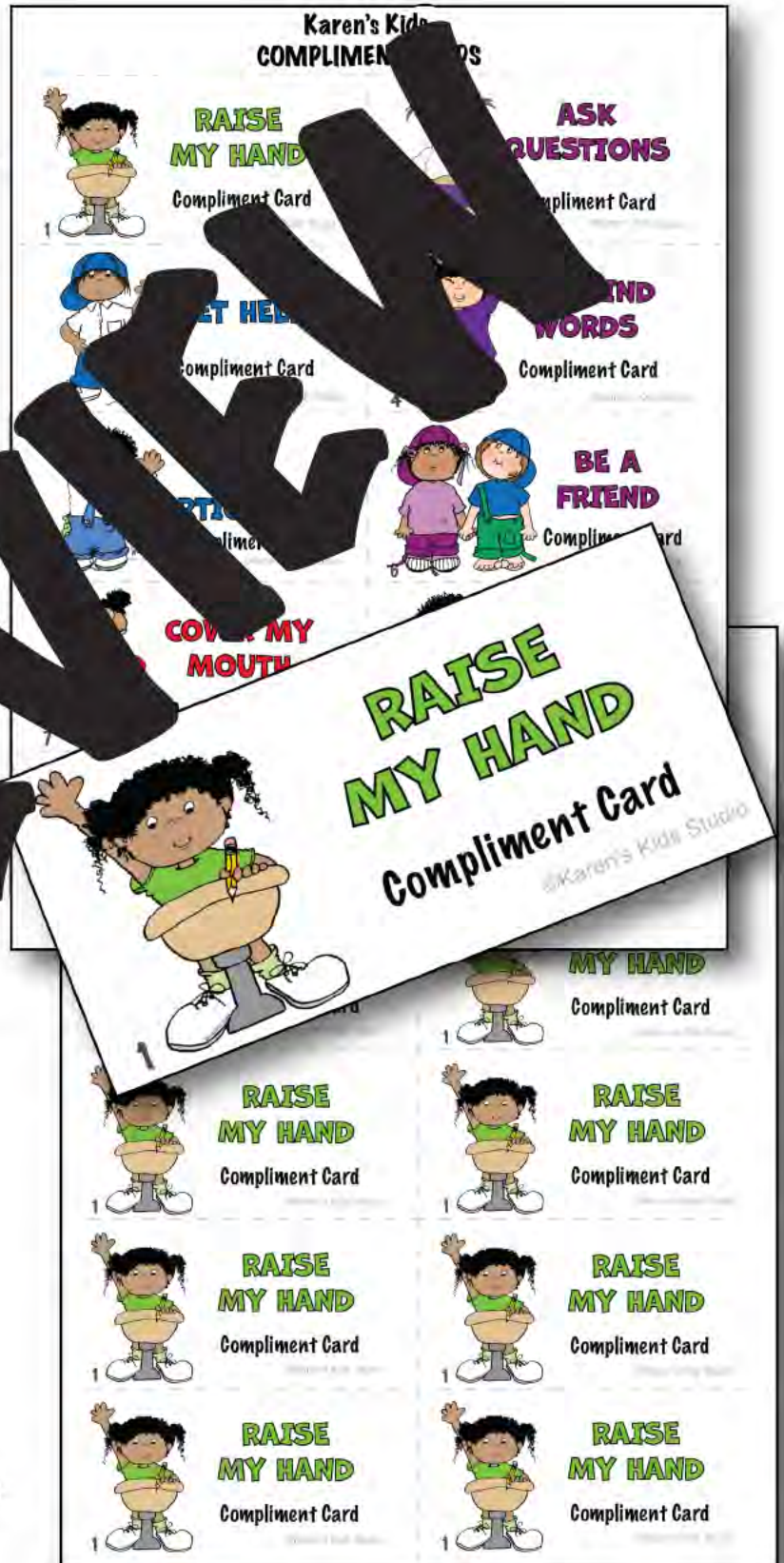
Print one copy of each of the 4 variety pages and refer to the numbers on them in your BINDER OR ORGANIZER.

NUMBERS

The small number in the bottom left corner of the Compliment Cards match the numbers on the Rules Cards. The Self-Check Student Form has a list of each of the numbered rules as well.

COLLECTING CARDS

Punch holes in the corners so students can store their cards on a ring. Messages can be written on the back.



CLASSROOM RULES STUDENT SELF-CHECK

SELF-CHECK FORM

Student Self-Check forms allow students the ability to monitor themselves and be responsible for a specific rule-goal. On the left side of the form there is a list of all of the classroom rule titles with their corresponding numbers.

RULE OF THE WEEK

In the bubble shape on the right students write a rule number. They use words and/or pictures to describe the rule they will be working on for the week.

HOW WILL I ACCOMPLISH THE

In the rectangle shape students write and draw examples of how the goal might be accomplished.

RATING SCALE

Students evaluate and rate their own achievement using the Rating Scale. 0=keep working on it, 1=not good, 2=good but need to do better, 3=good but need to do better, 4=good but need to do better, 5=accomplished goal.

SHARING

When it is time to select a new goal it is helpful for students to share their definitions and examples with each other.

RULES LIST

A Rules List Chart can be posted, sent to parents letting them know the classroom behavior goals, and/or given to students as a reference and stored in their personal CLASSROOM GOALS BINDER.

RULE OF THE WEEK

The individual cards make it easy to fit within different sized spaces on a wall.

BULLETIN BOARD HEADER

Use the PDF or the clip art bulletin board header. You can enlarge the clip art image to fit your space. The font used in this set is called MARVIN. Print on cardstock and laminate for years of use.

FOCUS ARROWS

Use the PDF or the clip art arrows to point to the rules you want to focus on. There are 7 arrows that match the fonts used in the posters. Pull the clip art arrows into your typing program to add text and then enlarge them to match your space. (Or handwrite your text.)

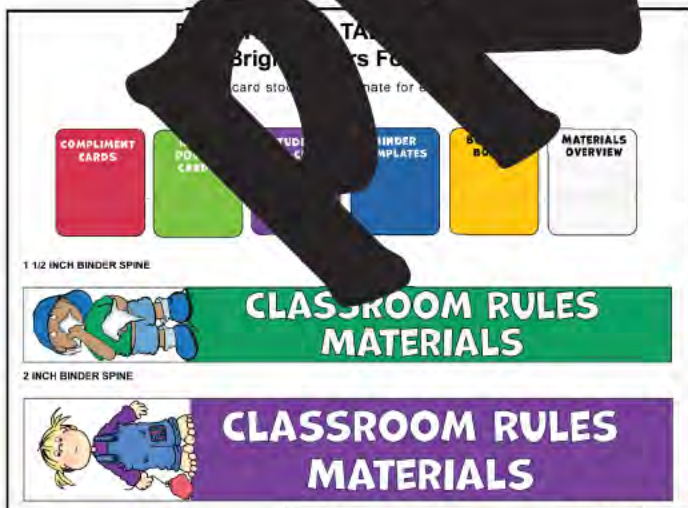
Binder Spines
