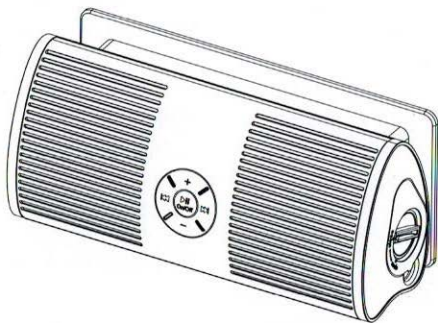

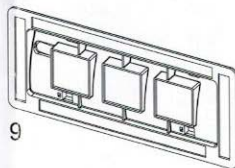
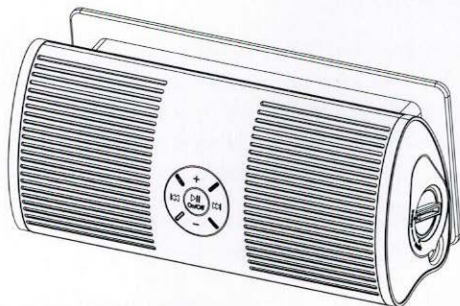

Getting Started



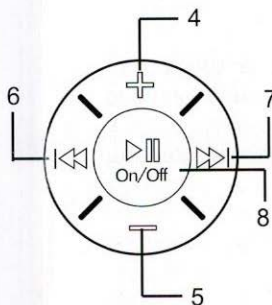
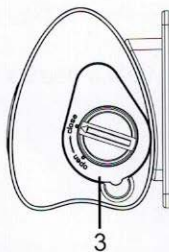
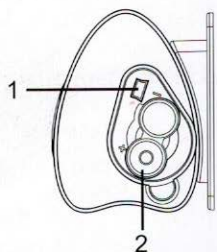

1. USB Port

Located inside battery compartment

2. Battery Compartment

4 AA batteries included

3. Battery Cover

Must be locked and flush to the unit to keep water out

4. Volume up +

Press to increase volume.

5. Volume down -

Press to lower volume.

6. Back /<<

Press to repeat song.

7. Forward >>/

Press to advance to next song.

8. Power Switch/ Play /Pause

Press and hold to turn on/off – Press to play/pause

9. Bracket

Once installed, allow 24 hours to cure to wall

10. Silicone

Use entire tube when installing

11. Double Sided Tape

Peel all three pieces before installing

12. USB Wire

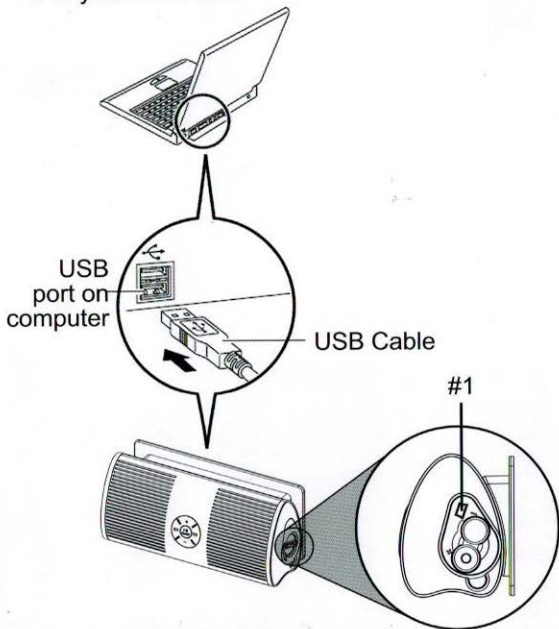
Used to connect STORMp3 to computer

13. Reset Button

Located on back of STORMp3

Getting Started: Connecting To Your Computer

Open the battery compartment to locate the USB port (#1). Using the included USB wire, connect your STORMp3 to your computer. You will see a STORMp3 icon appear on your computer screen. Open that file to begin. The batteries do not need to be installed when connecting your STORMp3 to your computer with your USB wire



Adding Music

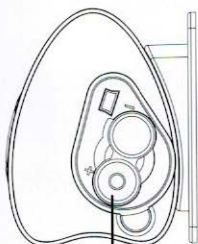
You can transfer music from your computer to your STORMp3 by using the drag and drop method.

- 1). Connect STORMp3 to your computer with the USB wire (allow up to 20 seconds for the computer and STORMp3 to sync).
 - a). **For Mac:** a STORMp3 icon will appear on your main screen
 - b). **For PC:** a pop up screen will appear. Choose "open folder to view files"
- 2). Open your music library that contains your music files on your computer.
- 3). With both your music library folder and STORMp3 file folder open on your computer screen, click and hold the song file you would like from your computer library folder. Then drag it over to the STORMp3 file folder. Transfer individual songs or multiple songs at a time, but please don't add multiple different FOLDERS of songs onto STORMp3. This will affect the shuffle play.
- 4). Once you're done adding your songs, make sure you disconnect the STORMp3 correctly. This will avoid any songs from getting lost:
 - a). **For Mac:** Click and hold the STORMp3 icon on your computer main page. You will see the trash can icon become an EJECT icon. Now drop the STORMp3 icon over the EJECT icon.
 - b). **For PC:** Right click the STORMp3 icon in the left column of the opened file. A screen will appear with the option to "EJECT". Simply click that option to eject.

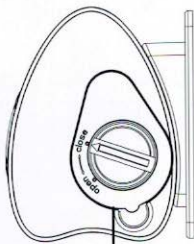

Installing Batteries

Insert 4 AA batteries (#2) and replace the battery cover (#3).

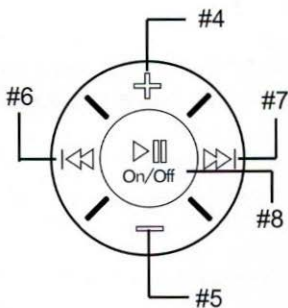

Make sure the battery cover is flush to the unit and locked, to ensure your STORMp3 is protected from water entering.

Playing Your Music

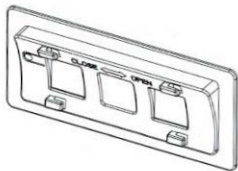
To listen to your music, press and hold the on/off button (#8) . The button will light up and your music will begin to play. To adjust the volume, use the + (#4) and - (#5). To change songs, press ← (#6) and → (#7).



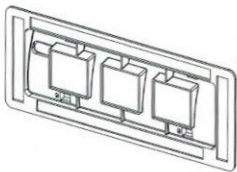
Your music will play in shuffle mode giving you a random song each time. To pause your music, press and release the on/off button (#8). To restart your music, press and release the on/off button again (#8). To shut off your STORMp3, press and hold the on/off button (#8) until the light turns off.

Installing Your Wall Bracket

Make sure to clean and dry your wall before installing the bracket. Use all 3 pieces of double sided tape. Make sure to apply all the silicone provided. Spread the silicone all over the back of the bracket (there should be none left over). When you apply the bracket to the wall, give a firm press and hold for 5 seconds. This will ensure that the silicone was spread evenly and that the tape made good contact with the wall. Wipe away any silicone that may spread over the side of the bracket.

Removing Songs and Resetting STORMp3

To remove songs from your STORMp3 using your computer, attach the same way you would to add songs with USB cable. Once connected to your computer, open the STORMp3 file and you will see the songs currently on your STORMp3. To remove individual songs:

PC users: locate the song(s) you want to delete and with your mouse, click that song once to highlight it. Now press delete on your keyboard and the song has been removed.

Mac users: locate the song(s) you want to delete and with your mouse, click and drag those files into your trash bin. You must now delete the file from your computers trash bin to complete the removal process from your STORMp3. If you do not clear the song from your trash bin, the song will still play on your STORMp3 even though you don't see the file when you connect STORMp3 to your computer.

Resetting your STORMp3 will remove all songs permanently. While the STORMp3 is playing music, using a toothpick or paperclip, press and hold the button on the back of the unit. After 3 seconds you will hear the STORMp3 go silent. Your STORMp3 file folder is now empty.
