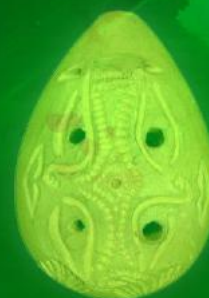

Important note about instruments:

The first keyswitch is activated by default. That means that if no other keyswitch is held, C1 articulation will sound. To activate a different keyswitch you need to hold down the key while playing.
