SURFACE PREPARATION

Dry Wall

Surface Preparation: Remove hardware, accessories, plates and similar items to allow dry erase coatings to be installed. I. Repair damaged areas by filling voids with spackle. Sand smooth repaired or textured surfaces. Scuff glossy and non-porous surfaces using medium grit sandpaper. Paint product is a high gloss coating; imperfections and visible seams will telegraph.

II. Plaster Surface: Remove surface chalk. In new work use moisture meter to determine moisture content. Do not begin installation when moisture content is greater than five percent.

III. Gypsum Board Surface: Provide Level 4 finish per ASTM C840 and GA-214. Recess nails and screws. Repair irregular tape joints, sand and remove dust.

IV. Previously Painted Surface: Remove loose paint or scale. Sand surface of enamel or gloss paint and remove dust with tack cloth or denatured alcohol

B. Prime substrate using materials recommended by manufacturer. Prime surface

until the color of the existing surface does not show through.

C. Ventilate area thoroughly to prevent the odor from permeating to other areas

the building. Provide 100 percent outside air ventilation of application areas..*

ADDITIONAL PREPARATION

Open windows, doors and HVAC system to 100% air exhaust to ventilate the area.

If you have to use a fan, avoid pointing it directly at the surface being painted.

Use painter's tape to mask surfaces and edges you do not want painted.

IMPORTANT: After application, be sure to remove tape while paint is still wet.

Wear protective eye-wear and gloves. Follow additional safety precautions according to the IdeaPaint Safety Data Sheet found on ideapaint.com/help.

Do not shake cans. Pour THIS into THAT and stir thoroughly or 2 minutes. DO NOT mix more than 50 sq. ft. of IdeaPaint at one time.

Once IdeaPaint is mixed, you have 1 HOUR to apply.

When installing IdeaPaint, apply the product 50 sq. ft. at a time. Do not stretch the product beyond the square footage denoted on the box.

When applying more than 50 sq. ft., mark every 50 sq. ft. on your drop cloth with a piece of tape, for reference.

For larger-scale installations, replace the roller cover after every 50 sq. ft. of product applied.

APPLICATION

Comply with manufacturers printed installation instructions. Mix components in strict accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Pot life is 1 hour maximum. B. Apply dry erase coating with specified roller only. Comply with the following: I. Apply heavy single coat ONLY. Do not recoat or touch up applied

- coating.

 II. Paint surface by working from one end to the other.
- III. Begin by cutting in the edges of an approximately 2 foot wide section.
- IV. Paint 2 foot wide section, maintaining a wet edge.
- V. Roll new section into wet edge.
 VI. Continuously check for skips, holes, and holidays as application progresses.
- VII. Remove masking tape within 1 hour of painting.
- C. Coating shall cure for a minimum of 7 days after application before use.
 D. Application Rate: Maximum 50 square feet per quart..

CAUTIONS
