BILSTER BERG JUNE 2020

▪ **Entry Control**

- All participants will be checked at the track entrance (“guest list”). Please submit the names of all participants (drivers, passengers and team members) before the event to avoid wait times

▪ **Transponder**

- All cars must be fitted with a transponder to comply with the local noise regulations. You’ll receive the transponders and mounting equipment from us at the check-in
- The transponders must be mounted at the front of the car at a maximum of 60cm above the ground. The transponder’s logo must be visible and the black bottom part must face the ground
- The participant is responsible for the transponder throughout the day and has to ensure its mounted correctly. Cars without a transponder are not allowed to enter the track
- Please notify us immediately if you loose a transponder

▪ Open Pitlane

- Generally, all cars are allowed to enter the track at any time. However, we are checking that there are never more than 30 cars on the track at the same time
- If there are more than 30 cars on the track, you may be asked to wait in the pitlane for a couple of minutes until other participants have left the track
- The speed limit in the pitlane is 50km/h

▪ Marshalls and Flags

- In addition to the traditional flags we discussed in Part I of the E-Briefing, the Bilster Berg also has LED-Boards replicating the flags electronically (Electronic Marshalling System). On top of that, there is an LED-Board giving you additional information (We'll show you its track position on page 7 of this briefing):
 - *Grid Number + TEC*: Technical issue / damage or breach of noise limit -> Come to the pitlane immediately
 - *Grid Number + BLA*: Black Flag -> Come to the pitlane immediately
 - *FIN*: End of Session-> Come to the pitlane immediately

▪ Lunch Break

- Due to the current regulations surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, you are only allowed to enter the restaurant in separate groups of around 25 people. The groups have been set up according to your grid numbers:
 - *Grid Numbers 1 – 25:* 12.00pm
 - *Grid Numbers 26 – 50:* 12.30pm
 - *Remainder of Participants:* 13.00pm
- Please let us know if you want to change your lunch-group after you received your grid numbers

▪ Additional Information

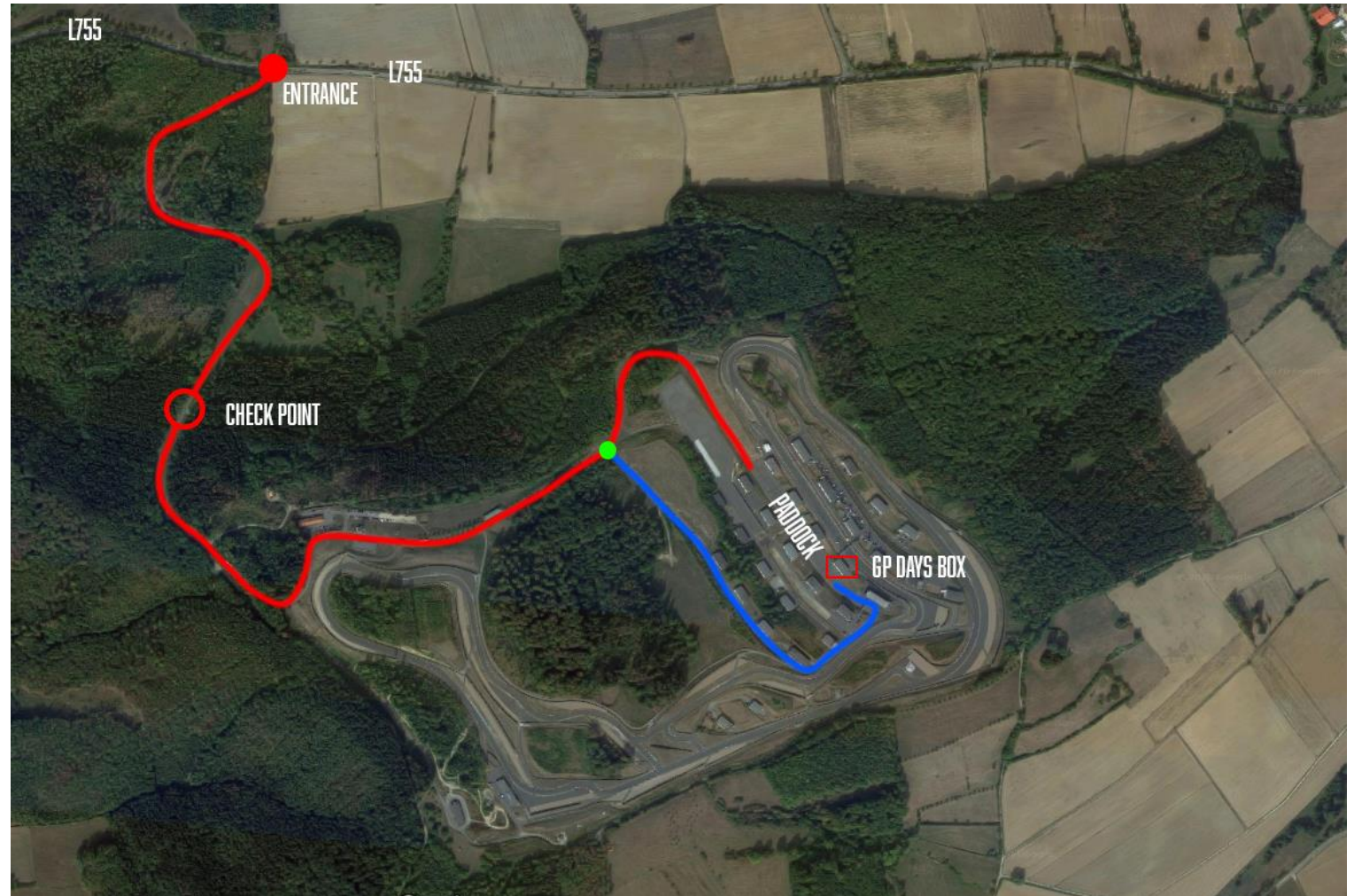
- Fuelling up is only allowed at the petrol station located right at the pit entry

Arriving at the Track – **Address: Bilster Berg 1, 33014 Bad Driburg**



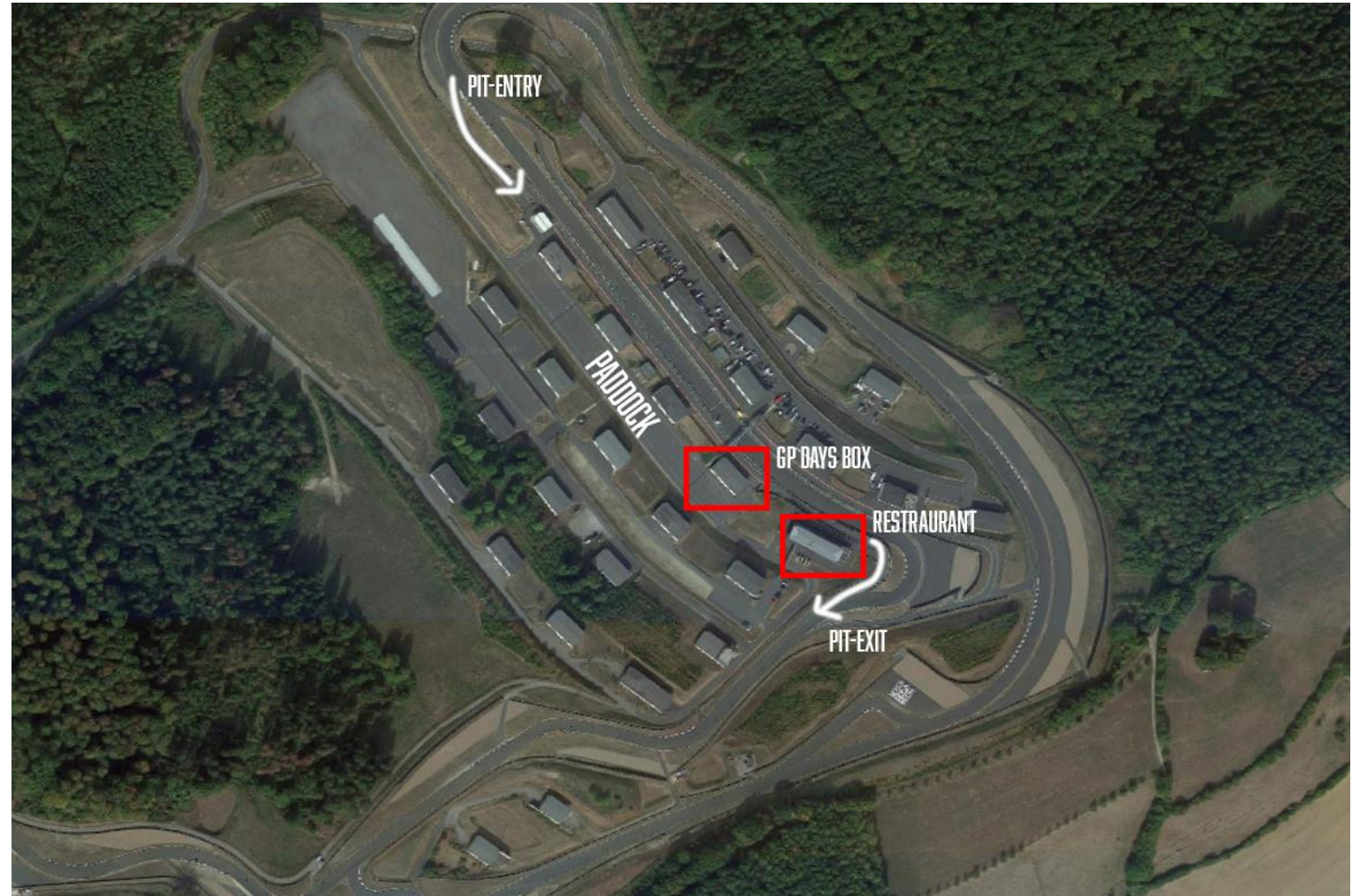
- You'll arrive via the L755. Turn right or left (depending from which direction you arrive) to enter the access road to the track
- Shortly after, you'll arrive at the Check Point where an employee of the Bilster Berg Drive Resort will check your name
- Follow the road (red line) until you reach the paddock
- We'll hand out the grid numbers and transponders at the green circle in the morning
- If we are not there once you arrive (or if you arrive later), you can pick up all the things you need in our box in the paddock

The Premises

- You'll always find one of our team members in our box in case you have any questions during the Track Day
- We'll also provide hot and cold drinks throughout the day which you can pick up at any time
- The restaurant will offer lunch for all our participants. Please mind the groups we put in place
- Please try to keep the minimum distance of 1.5m while parking in the paddock

Circuit Overview

Joining the Track

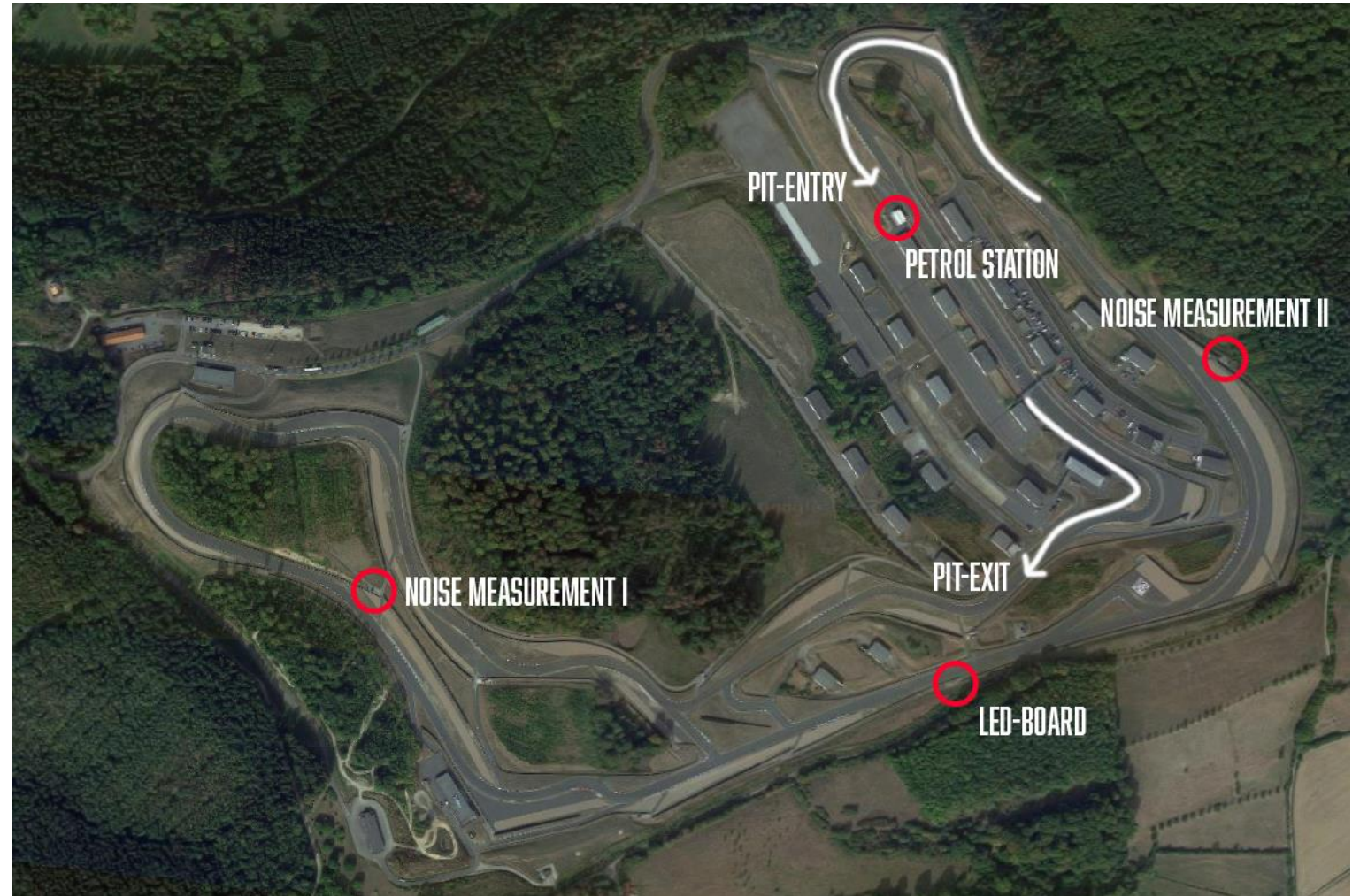
- Stick to the right and watch your mirrors. Cars already on the track have the right of way – don't stop!

Noise Measurements

- Louder vehicles (Porsche GT3, Cayman GT4 etc.) should be aware of the measuring points. Breaching the local noise regulation will lead to immediate exclusion from the event

Entering the Pitlane:

- Use your indicator to make other drivers aware that you're leaving the track
- The petrol station is located right at the entrance of the pitlane

Bilster Berg and COVID-19



- Please download our COVID-19 information package for a more detailed view on all the measures put in place by the local authorities
- Please be aware, that breaching the rules will lead to the immediate exclusion from the event
- We kindly ask you to only bring one additional person to the track if possible
- Only drivers, passengers or support team members (for race cars) are allowed to enter the premises of the track
- Spectators are not allowed to join the Track Day or enter the premises of the Bilster Berg Drive Resort
