

NOISE QUOTA – BILSTER BERG

Special Rules for a Special Track

As you may have heard, we are facing special noise regulations at Bilster Berg which do not allow for an exact statement on how loud your vehicle can be. Our guidance is set at 126db(A) measured according to the _{LWA}-Method. Emissions are recorded at two spots around the circuit.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Experience shows, that cars like Porsche GT3s, Cayman GT4s etc., can be louder than the limit laid out above (if driven fast).

Imagine the Noise Quota like a barrel. At the beginning of the Track Day, we are starting out with an empty barrel. Each passing car fills up the barrel throughout the day. The louder the car, the faster the Barrell fills up.

Once the barrel is filled up completely, we have to end the Track Day, even if there is still some time left. This means, that extremely loud cars may spoil the fun for everyone!

As a result, we have are running a "Zero-Tolerance"-approach regarding cars breaching the 126 db(A) ($_{LWA}$ -method) restrictions.

For some cars (e.g. Porsche) silencers can be rented on track. Please let us know well in advance whether you will need one.
