“I’m tired too. We want to go read stories inside,” says Mia.



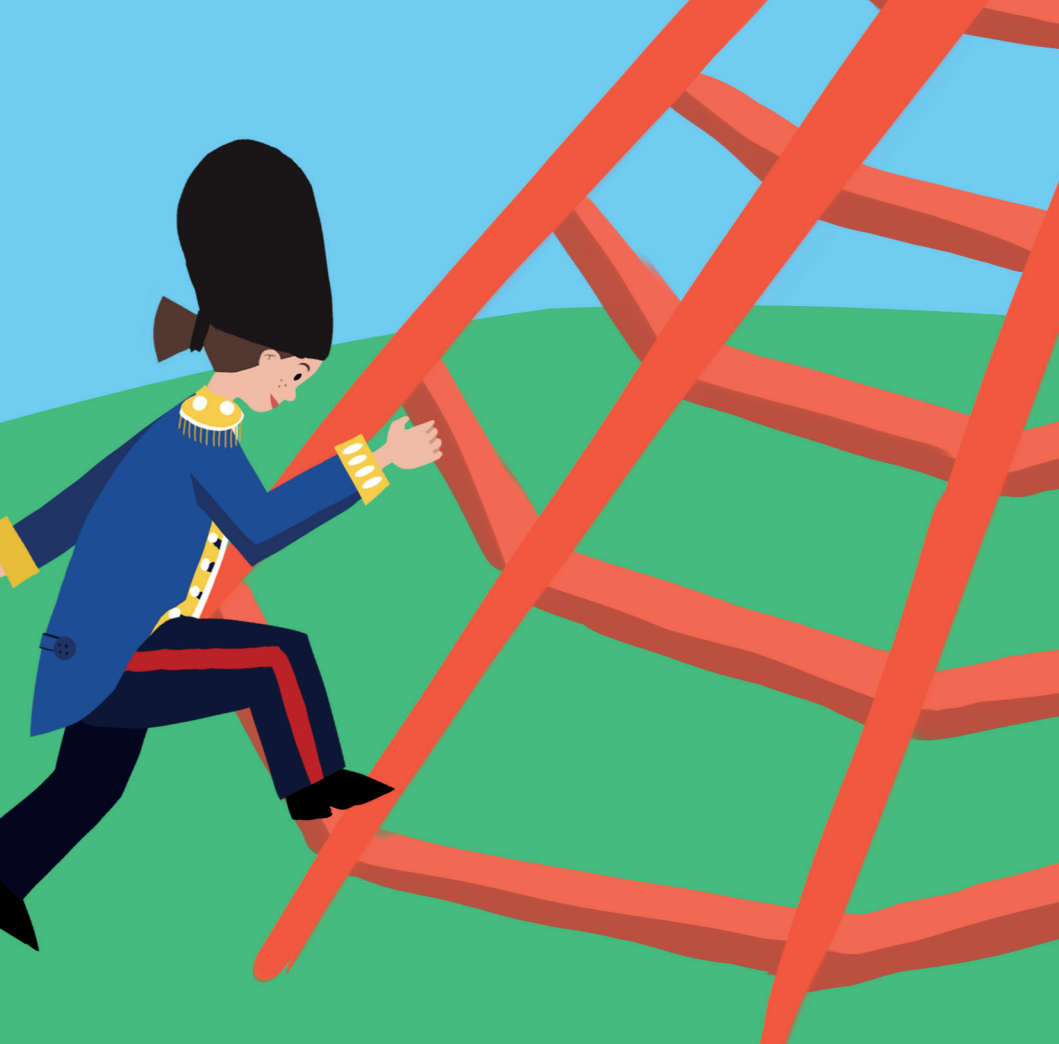
The Littlest General gets mad. She stomps her feet. She crosses her arms.
