

HOW TO GET THE BEST OUT OF YOUR ARTWORK

The starting point and most important aspect of a screen printing job is your design.

Making sure that your artwork file is sent across to us correctly is crucial...

Colour Format: CMYK File Format: PSD, AI, PDF, TIFF, EPS File Resolution: 300dpi

A few tips to get the best results...

Create your artwork with the resolution at 300dpi – the larger and clearer your file is, the better the end result when printed. Please note, we don't accept 72dpi files as they are not adequate to create a quality job

Think about the placement and sizing of your artwork on the t-shirt - a design with lots of detail might work best as an oversize front or back print, rather than a small left chest print.

If you're supplying a vector file, please make sure all your fonts are outlined.

We will separate your artwork for print for free if the file is high quality. If your file needs a lot of work, or needs recreating, we can do this but we may charge.
