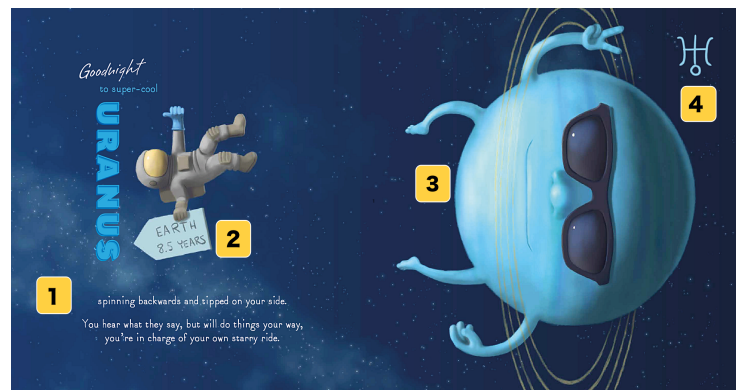
FOUR LEARNINGS ON EVERY PAGE
