FACILITIES

Arctic Quest

Arctic Quest is located just outside Tewkesbury in the scenic River Avon Valley, Please be aware this site is super basic with a gravel road and grass fields. There is running water onsite and facilities including toilets and showers. Depending on weather will depend on pitches but we will be able to cater for all weathers and all types of accommodation so caravans, motor homes and tents (I just cant provide the sunshine)

There will be onsite food, but this maybe quite basic so you may want to bring extra!

We will be running on gravel and grass trails with varying distances to cope with different dogs fitness and ability.

Directions

We are only 10 minutes from the M5.

From the M5

Leave the M5 at junction 9. Head towards Tewkesbury and turn right at the first set of traffic lights, into Shannon Way. At the next set of traffic lights turn right and go over the motorway bridge.

Take the first turning left, through a housing estate and go over the motorway for a second time. At the T junction turn right onto the B4080 and then drive through Bredon's hardwick as you leave the village you will see the M5 motorway turn Left just before you go under the m5 (fleet lane) and then we are the 5th gate on the right – up a gravel track, you wont miss the signage!



Arrival to Site:

On arrival please check in at the member of staff waiting to check you in, there will be clear signs to entrance and where to go, You will need to arrive between check in times as the gate will be locked at night

All running of dogs will be subject to weather if too hot we will look at alternative activities for the dogs 'welfare.

We will be supporting the yellow dog campaign – meaning that if your dog does not do well in group situations, is on heat, etc then they will be required to wear a yellow ribbon/ bandana.

Dogs working will need to be 12 months or older. Please enquire further if you dog is just under this age to talk about what we can do for you

All dogs that will be working need to be fit, healthy and physically capable of working in harness.

All dogs will need to be fully vaccinated and free from KC. We strongly recommend having your dog vet checked before working to make sure there are no health problems.

The site is my home and where I work so the usual courtesy towards members of the public locally would be appreciated and my neighbours.

There will be a Meal provided on the Saturday evening, which is included in the full weekend pass.

All dog's mess needs to be cleaned up, anyone acting inappropriately will be asked to leave.

We recommend bringing your own helmet (cycling, snowboard, etc), but do have some if required and a correctly fitting working harness for your dogs. We do provide harnesses, but please be aware these are sized for our team and we have limited selection so if your dog is huge please bring a harness

There will be stalls on site to purchase dog and working related products.
