



Big Wool Hat

a pattern by Sara Heckman

Yarn: 1 skein super bulky or 90 yards

Malabrigo Rasta

Wool Addicts Fire

Baah Yarn Sequoia

Needles: US 15, 16" circulars

Gauge: 2.5 sts/inch in stockinette

Directions:

Using US 15 needles, cast on 44 stitches. Join for knitting in the round. Place a marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Round 1-8:

(Knit one, purl one), repeat () to the end of the round.

Next:

Knit every stitch around until hat measures 9 inches from the cast on edge.

Decrease round 1 :

Knit two stitches together, repeat to the end of the round. (22sts)

Decrease round 2:

(Knit the next two stitches together), repeat () to the end of the round. (11sts)

Finishing:

Cut a long tail. Thread tail onto a tapestry needle and weave through all remaining stitches. Pull tight and fasten off on the wrong side.
