

Apricot Yarn & Supply

Hue Hue Hat

A pattern by Sara Heckman



Yarn: Sport weight in two colors, approx 20g each color

Needles: US 3 + US 4, dpns or 12" circulars

Finished size: 12"cir (14", 16")

Size: Newborn, Baby, Toddler

Gauge: 6 stitches/ inch

Tools: stitch marker, tapestry needle

How to Make:

On US 3 needles with color A, cast on 72(88,96) stitches.

Place a marker between the first and last stitch.

Join for working in the round in a 2 x 2 rib pattern.

2x2 rib pattern = K2, P2; repeat to the end of the round.

Work 12 rounds of ribbing.

Switch needles to US4 and knit every round for 10(12,16) rounds.

Switch to color B. Knit 15(18,20) rounds.

Decreases:

Round 1: (Knit 6, k2tog), repeat to the end of round.

Round 2: Knit every stitch

Round 3: (Knit 5, k2tog), repeat to the end of round.

Round 4: repeat rnd 2

Round 5: (Knit 4, k2tog), repeat to the end of round.

Round 6: repeat rnd 2

Round 7: (Knit 3, k2tog), repeat to the end of round.

Round 8: repeat rnd 2

Round 9: (Knit 2, k2tog), repeat to the end of round.

Round 10: repeat rnd 2

Round 9: (Knit 1, k2tog), repeat to the end of round.

Round 10: K2tog to end of round.

Finish:

Cut a long tail, thread onto a tapestry needle and weave yarn through remaining stitches on the needles. Pull knitting needles out of work and cinch stitches on the tail tightly together. Fasten off on the wrong side of the hat by weaving under stitches.
