



# *Snappy Cowl*

—a quick project for the last minute

**Yarn:** 1 skein super bulky or 90 yards

**Notes:**

Malabrigo Rasta

Wool Addicts Fire

Baah Yarn Sequoia

**Needles:** US 15, 24" circulars

**Gauge:** 2.5 sts/inch in stockinette

**Size:** approx 8 inches tall by 22-24 inches circumference

Notes: The pattern for this cowl creates a slide of four knits and four purl that move over one stitch with each round

completed. You should see a diagonal pattern emerge as

you knit.

**Directions:**

Using US 15 needles, cast on 55 stitches. Join for knitting

in the round.

Knit 4 stitches, purl 4 stitches, continuing in pattern around and around, until you have 3 yards of yarn remaining. Bind

off loosely.

**Finishing:**

Thread remaining yarn onto a tapestry needle and weave through four or five stitches on the wrong side. Trim.
