

Whimbrel Blanket

Materials

- Yarn: 4 skeins Quince & Co Whimbrel or 720 yds worsted weight yarn
- Needles: US 8 needles 32"-40"
- Gauge: We recommend using the yarn weight and needle recommended
- Finished measurements: 25x32

How to Make

Border Pattern:

Loosely cast on 150 stitches. (long tail cast on recommended)

Border row 1 (RS): (P1, K1) repeat () to end.

Border row 2 (WS): (K1, P1) repeat () to end.

Border row 3 (RS): (P1, k1) repeat () to end.

Border row 4 (WS): (K1, P1) repeat () to end.

Border row 5 (RS): (P1, k1) repeat () to end.

Border row 6 (WS): (K1, P1) repeat () to end.

Set up row:(RS): P1, k1, p1, k1, p1, place marker, K4, (p2, k3), repeat until 6 stitches remain, P1 ,PM, K1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Begin Blanket body pattern beginning with **ROW 2**

Blanket body pattern:

Row 1(RS): P1, k1, p1, k1, p1, SM, K4, (p2, k3), repeat () until 1 stitch before marker, P1,SM, K1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Row 2 (WS): K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, SM, K1, p3, (k2, p3) repeat () across until 1 stitch before marker, K1, SM, p1, k1, p1, k, p1.

Row 3(RS): P1, k1, p1, k1, p1, SM, K1,(sl 1 st knitwise, k2, lift the slipped st over the 2 sts just knitted, p2) repeat () until 1 stitch before marker, P1, SM, K1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Row 4(WS): K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, SM, P1, (P1, yo, P1, k2) repeat () until 5 sts remain, P1, yo, P1, K1, SM, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1.

Repeat four Blanket Body rows, until the blanket measures approximately 31 inches from the cast on, ending with Row 4.

Repeat border rows 1-6. Bind off all stitches loosely. Weave in ends
