Apricot Yarn & Supply Yellowfin Bandana

Materials

- Yarn: Kelbourne Woolens Mojave, 2 skeins
- Hook: US7
- Gauge: 4 treble clusters= 4inches
- **Other:**split ring marker
- Finished measurements: height at center spine 21.5", length 54"

How to make

Using US 7 hook, ch 4 and join with sl st into first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 5, then 2 tr into the center ring, next create center stitch by 3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr into center of ring, then make 3 tr. Mark the chain in the center treble cluster with a split ring marker to help track this center spine stitch.

Row 2: Ch5, work 2 tr between the last and next to last tr of the previous row, work 3 tr in the next space between tr and center sts, then into the center chain work (3tr, ch1, 3 tr), then3 tr in next space, then 2 tr between the 1 st tr and the ch of the previous row, 1 tr in the 4th ch of the previous row.

Row 3: Ch 5, work 2 tr between the last and next to the last tr of the previous row, 3 tr in each space between treble sets, then work (3 tr, ch1, 3 tr) into the center ch, work 3 tr between treble sets until last set, then work 2 tr between the first tr and the 5ch of the previous row, 1 tr in the 4 th chain of the previous row.

Row 4: Ch 5, work 2 tr between the last and the next to last tr of the previous row, always work 3 tr between the groups of the previous row up to the center, in the center ch work (3 tr, ch1, 3tr), then 3 tr between each group of the previous row, 2 tr between the 1st tr and ch of the previous row, 1 tr in the 4th ch of the previous row.

Repeat Row 4 until piece measures 21.5" along center spine.
