- TURN UP**
- Quick-start Guide
1. Fully charge Lucyd LOUD with included cable.
 2. Turn on Bluetooth on device you wish to connect it to.
 3. Hold the "+" button on the LOUD for three seconds to turn it on. Then hold the "-" button for three seconds to enable pairing. Then select "G1" in the available Bluetooth devices on phone or computer. (It will pair automatically when in range from then on).
 4. Your LOUD is now connected to your phone or PC! You can select music and make calls on your connected device or by giving voice commands to the virtual assistant.
 5. Tap the touchpad lightly to play or pause music. Swipe backwards to play the next track and swipe forward to go back a track. Similarly, swipe backwards to answer a call and forward to decline it or hang up.
 6. Long-tap to open the virtual assistant, wait for a tone then speak. Long-tap again to close the virtual assistant.
 7. Be sure to turn off your LOUD when not in use. Hold the "+" button for three seconds to power down. It will automatically power down in 15 minutes when the Bluetooth link is broken.

Instructions

Buttons

Power On: Hold the "+" button for 3 seconds until you hear a tone.

Power Off: Hold the "+" button for 3 seconds until you hear a tone. LOUD will automatically shut off after 15 minutes if the Bluetooth connection is broken.

Pairing

First, turn on Bluetooth on the device you want to pair LOUD with. Then hold the "-" button for three seconds until the LED flashes red and blue. Tap "G1" when it appears in the available devices on your phone or PC.

If your Loud is paired to a device, you may need to disconnect the Bluetooth connection to switch to a different device.

Auto-connection

Once LOUD has been paired with your device, it will automatically pair again when powered on and in range.

Volume Control

LOUD gives you the freedom to control volume with the buttons on the right stem, via your phone or via your phone's virtual assistant. The "+" button increases volume and the "-" button decreases it. A tone will play when the maximum volume is reached.

Music Control

Play/Pause: Lightly tap touchpad on left stem.

Previous Track: Lightly swipe forward on the touchpad.

Next Track: Lightly swipe backwards on the touchpad.

Phone Control

Answer a call: Lightly swipe backwards on the touchpad.

Decline or hang up: Light swipe forwards on the touchpad.

Switch call: When a new call comes in while already on one, swipe forward to decline or swipe backwards to hang up current call and switch to the new one.

Virtual Assistant Control

To activate Siri, Google Voice, Bibby or Alexa: Long-tap the touchpad for three seconds. You should hear a tone prompting you to speak. Long-tap again to decline.

Note: The virtual assistant should be set to be active even when the phone is locked. Check your settings if you are unable to initiate voice commands while phone is locked.

Charging Info

Voltage: 5V 500mA is recommended.

Charge time: Approx. two hours. Plugging USB cable into a wall outlet adapter will reduce charge time versus charging from a computer USB port. LED will shine red when charging, and turn off when fully charged. Charge fully before use.

Low Battery Reminder: You will hear a tone sound when the battery is low.

Safety Tips

- *LOUD is not recommended for use while driving, motorcycling, operating machinery or bicycling.
- *LOUD is not recommended for use at maximum volume. Prolonged exposure to loud sounds can cause hearing damage.
- *LOUD is not recommended for use by children.
- *Please do not dismantle the product as it may lead exposure to battery chemicals or sharp objects.
- *Be respectful of others when using LOUD. At medium to high volumes others may be able to hear what you are listening to.

Caring for your Lucyd LOUD

- *Power down when not in use. Unplug when charging is complete.
- *Keep away from water, moisture and excessive humidity.
- *Keep away from fire and excessive heat.
- *Keep away from sharp objects which can damage the LOUD.
- *Store in a dry place at room temperature.
- *Prescription lenses are susceptible to rapid temperature changes. Only use the LOUD in a stable environment.

Touchpad

Press for three seconds to start/turn on voice control.
Swipe forward/backwards to repeat/answer a phone call.
Swipe forward/backwards to select/unselect music song.
Tap lightly to pause/resume music.

Stem Buttons

*Hold "+" button for three seconds to power on/off.
*Hold "-" button for three seconds to pair.
*Press "+" or "-" to increase/decrease volume. Tone sounds at max volume.

Micro USB Port

Tips

Avoid getting your Lucyd Loud wet, especially near the USB jack.

Avoid having your phone volume on maximum for optimal sound quality.

Hair may get in the way of the touch control pad. Make sure the area is free of obstruction for accurate controls. The touchpad is very sensitive and only takes a light, quick touch.

You can use Siri™ or another virtual assistant to perform a number of commands with just your voice, such as dialing a contact, checking the weather, using certain apps, or getting directions.
