


# THE OFFICIAL INTERNATIONAL RING SIZE CONVERSION CHART

## Sizing Tool

Use the circles below to judge sizes against your existing rings. Make sure you line the circles up below with the inside of your band to get an idea of size.

Cut a slit along the top line and wrap it around your finger pushing the pointed end through the slit and measuring the size there. Remember that the ring will need to be snug but will still need to fit over the largest part of your finger.</p>
