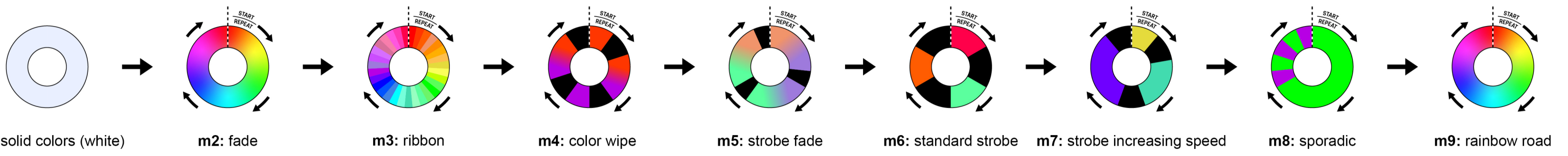


## MAIN MENU (m1-m9)

- The RGB Critter's Main Menu consists of 9 different modes (m1–m9) that you can explore using the Arrow button (see Main Menu graphic below). Each mode is either a solid color (m1) or a repeating pattern of fades and/or strobes (m2–m8). The Rainbow Road (m9) contains 20 presets (m9 preset 1–m9 preset 20).



m1: solid colors (white)

m2: fade

m3: ribbon

m4: color wipe

m5: strobe fade

m6: standard strobe

m7: strobe increasing speed

m8: sporadic

m9: rainbow road

## RETURN TO MAIN MENU (m1-m9)

- If at any point you want to return to the Main Menu (m1–m9), simply use a short hold of the Power button.

## SOLID COLORS (m1)

- m1 contains 39 solid color options. To view these solid color options, find m1 (color: white) and press the Rocket button 1x. You are now able to explore the 39 colors using the Arrow and Rocket buttons.

## ACCESSING PRESETS

- Each mode m1–m8 contains 4 presets. The presets use the same pattern as the selected mode (m1–m8). For example, m2 is the "fade mode" (1 color fading into the next, then repeat). If you want to view more "fade mode" presets, you will access them within the presets of m2 (m2 preset 1–m2 preset 4).
- To view presets of m1–m8, navigate to the desired mode and use a long hold of the Arrow button until the first preset loads. Explore the presets using the Arrow and Rocket buttons. Note: While holding the Arrow button, the LED will turn white. You need continue holding the Arrow button until the first preset loads.
- The Rainbow Road (m9) contains up to 20 presets. The Rainbow Road's presets are a combination of presets sourced from m1–m8.

## EXTRA INFORMATION

- When turning on the Critter for the first time, or after a factory reset, you will be viewing m1 (solid color: white). The Critter will always turn on in the last mode or preset used when it was turned off.
- Hold Durations:
  - Short: 1.5 seconds
  - Medium: 3 seconds
  - Long: 5 seconds
