

Consonants usually sound after the note.
In bars 1-16 and 21-40, each new syllable should be heard through the texture, sung with a slight tenuto and with consonants clearly audible.

## Pronunciation:

a as in father
e: as in beside (b'side). This is sung as in fur without the 'r' (similar to French deux)
e in ha'aretz as in pet
o as in shop
ai as in pie
ch as in the Scottish loch
tz as in pets
' is a glottal stop.
