46 **§** TIME

Let us have a good look at some of the figures most commonly used in § time. It is important to realise that this Compound Duple time consists of TWO DOTTED CROTCHET BEATS in a bar, or six quavers grouped in two lots of three.



Now a few simple musical examples.
