## Composition Activity

**Activity Size:** *small group or individual.*

Compose a sixteen-bar chorus or hook line in a Rock style similar to that found in the One Punch Man soundtrack. Your composition should include:

- 2 vocal melodies (including lyrics.)
- Lead Guitar (riffs/melodic lines.)
- Rhythm Guitar (rhythmic sequence including a chord progression.)
- Bass Guitar (harmonic bass line.)
- Drum kit (ostinato drum patterns.)

Think about the following in the composition process:

- How will you treat the vocal lines? Will there be a main vocal line with an accompanying style vocal line or will you have duet style vocal line?
- Think carefully about the choice of tonality, key and key signature, shape and structure of the melodic line.
- What chord structure will you use?
- What type of line will the Bass Guitar use?

Your composition will need to be performed and should display all concepts of music- Pitch, Duration, Tone colour, Texture, Structure, Dynamics and Performing Techniques.
