



Cute Winter Penguin

You will need a felting surface and a needle, my favourite is the Mum's Makery flatmat and my go to needle is the 40 spiral.

A set of pocket scales and a pair of sharp scissors will also be handy too.


Materials Used

Black	4 grams
White	1.25 grams
Bright Red	0.5 grams
Marigold	0.3 grams

Weights & Size are approx.

This is a fun set of templates which will make a cute winter penguin..

I am using 0.2 grams of Marigold for the feet and 2 grams of Black for the body.





Use 0.1 gram of wool for each foot, taking small pieces to felt into the toes first and then use the rest to fill it in.

Repeat for the other foot.



Anchor the feet in place if you need to and start to fill the body with the Black wool.

I have started with his wings and then used the rest to fill the template.



Now we have the beginning of our cute penguin.

To give him some shape I am adding 1.5 grams of Black in a pillow for the body.

Felt this evenly and firmly all over the shape.





To give it a smooth finish I have used a sheet weighing 0.5 grams of Black.

Place this over the whole shape and pop the template back over the shape.

Felt this all over for a neat finish.



Now for the chest piece.

With 1 gram of White fill the template and felt firmly all over.

To attach this to the body I have kept both shapes in the templates.

I found that it keeps everything together while I work on it.



Work your needle all the way around the outer edge of the template to attach the white to the black.

When that is done work all over the white piece attaching it completely to the black.





Starting to look like a penguin now.



For the face I have 0.1 gram of Marigold,0.1 gram of White split into two and a pinch of Black.

For the beak felt the Marigold into a diamond shape.



It will be attached in half like the picture.





So find the center and start to attach that to the center of the penguin just above the white chest.



Work on attaching and shaping until you are happy with the position and the overall look.

For the eyes roll each amount of White, 0.05 grams, into balls and attach by working around the edges.

This will keep them just proud of the face.



Now with a couple of pinches of Black rolled up felt those into the center of his eyes.





Now take some time to work all over your piece to make sure that there are not any stray fibres.

Tidy up around the eyes and beak.



Now for his hat and scarf.

The hat needs 0.25 grams of Bright Red and 0.15 grams of White.





I have placed his hat just above his eyes and felted it to the penguin firmly.





You could leave it like that if you want but I have added a bobble on top.



So I have used 0.15 grams of White rolled up into a ball and felted it on the top.

For his scarf I have 0.2 grams of Bright Red for the long template and 0.05 grams for the small template.



Again felt these both firmly on both sides.





Then attach them in the position that you are happy with.



There you have one large cute penguin.



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
