



## Hexagon Coaster

You will need a felting surface and a needle, my favourite is the flatmat and my go to needle is the 40 spiral.

A set of pocket scales, mini leaf templates and a pair of sharp scissors will also be handy too.

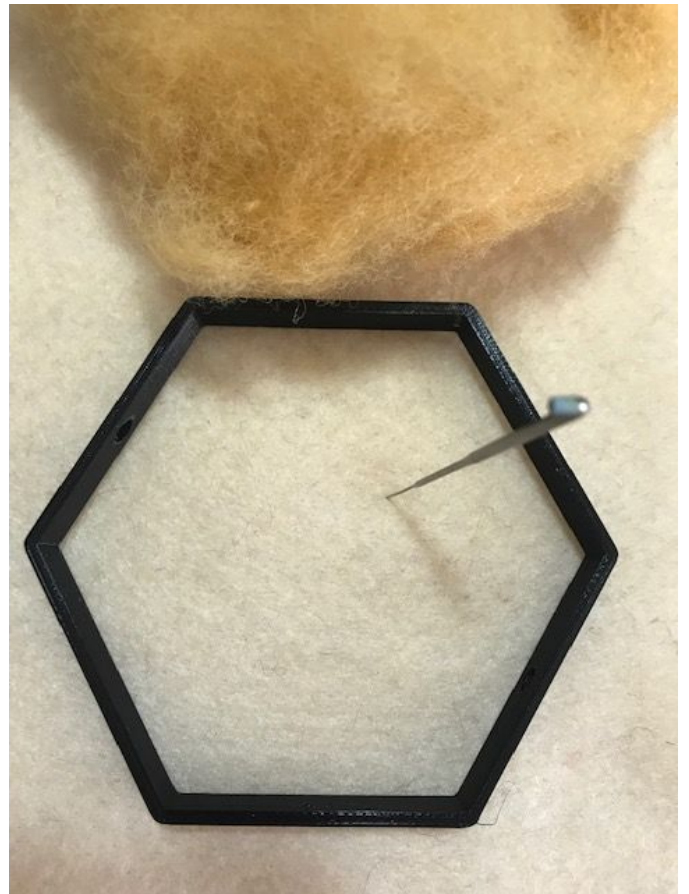
## Materials Used

|              |          |
|--------------|----------|
| Harvest Gold | 5 grams  |
| Evergreen    | 0.1 gram |

Weights & Size are approx.

For this demonstration I will be showing the ivy leaf decoration.

Take 4 grams of your main colour which for me is Harvest Gold.



Take small amounts from this and start to fill the edges of the template.

I do this with small amounts as each point gets filled with wool and it lets you fill the template evenly.



Take some time over felting this, use a multi tool if you have one.

If not you can hold two needles together or wrap a rubber band around them to hold them in place.

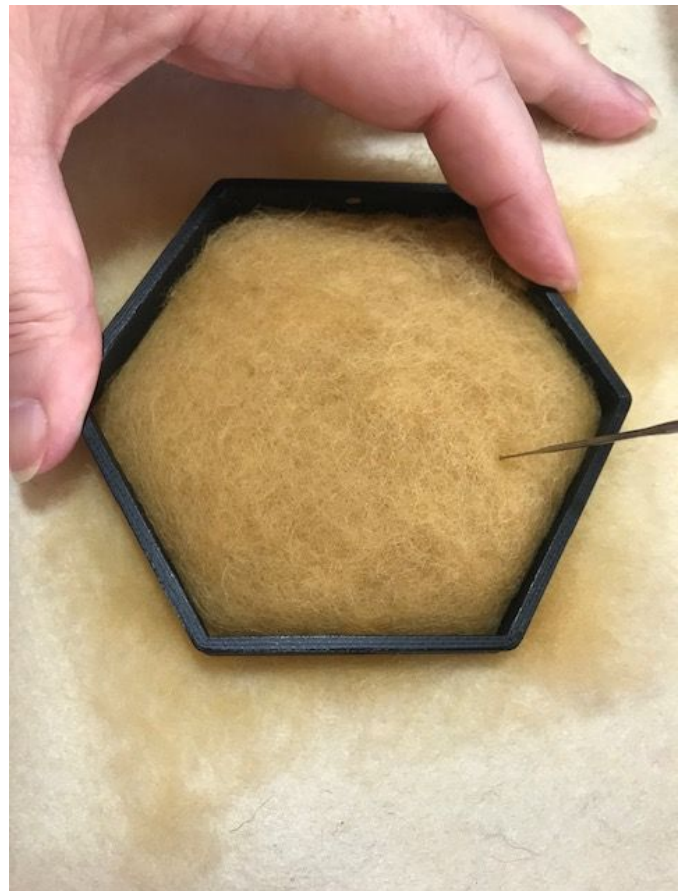
The finish is not great on this as I just wanted to get the shape firmly felted.

Now with 1 gram of the same colour.

Smooth this out into a thin sheet, you can rub it between your hands to knock the air out of it.

Lay this over your shape and then pop the template back over the top.

Felt this sheet to your shape



When the front side is firmly felted, turn your shape over and start to attach the overhang to the other side.



When this is complete I take my shape out of the template and just go around the edges to make sure everything is firmly attached.

Take care when doing this that you don't dent your shape or stab your fingers.



Now I have a nice and neat shape ready to decorate.

For my decorations I have decided on the mini leaf templates.

I have chosen the ivy for this one.



Place the template in the position that you want it and start to fill it in.

I used approximately 0.1 grams of wool for this and used Evergreen.



Then with just a pinch of Harvest Gold I draft out a very thin thread and secure one end to the tip of the leaf.

Then I twist the thread and felt it down in a straight line for the veins of the leaf.



Cut the thread when you reach the end of the line.

Repeat for the other sections.



I have made some variations, all using the mini leaf templates and the Hexagon Coaster template.

For the others I have used Ginger/ Warm Brown and the Mini Beech template.

Mustard, Cranberry and the Mini Oak leaf template.

All the veins are Harvest Gold.



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
