## Weights & Measures

Base colour 0.2-0.3g

Details Just a pinch

Start with 0.2g of fluff for your leaf, you can always add more later if you think it is too thin. Pay particular attention to the edges to get a nice finish. I did give mine a light press with a steam iron and then trimmed any stray fibres from the edge. Try introducing some blending to give your mini leaf some extra interest.





Take fine wisps of fluff and twist them to make the leaf vein details.



For the holly I find it easier to roll small sections into points and do the outer details first.



I think the oak leaf is one of my favourite shapes. Why not make some mini acorns to go with it as seen in our Autumn Fayre 2021 broadcast?



How cute does this Brooch look? It uses the ring from the Tree Stump template for the base shape.



The mini mistletoe is really sweet. Here I made a pair of festive earrings using pearl beads.
