You will need a felting surface, my favourite is the Flat mat and a 40 spiral needle.

Materials Used

Grey	4.8 grams
Black	1.6 grams
White	2.5 grams

Weights & Size are approx.

Template	2 D / Base Layer	2.5 D build up	Wool cover	Black
Small (Black)	0.6 grams	0.6 grams	0.3 grams	-
Medium (White)	1 gram	1 gram	0.5 grams	pinch
Large (Grey)	2 grams	2 grams	0.8 grams	pinch

For this demonstration I am using the large template and Grey wool.

To make a flat 2 D shape you will need to start with 2 grams of your chosen colour.



Take small amounts from this to start to fill your template.

I start with the small pointy bits like the tail and then ears, to make sure that those parts are filled.



When you have those parts done, fill in the rest of the template and firm it up on both sides.

Remember to turn your work over so that it doesn't stick to your felting surface.

Now you have a perfect Scotty Dog shape.

Now to make it 2.5 D and give a little definition to the shape.

So now with a further 2 grams of wool I am going to make small pillows to fatten up parts of the dog shape.

For his rump and hind leg I have a pillow of 0.6 grams.



For his shoulder and front leg the pillow is 0.4 grams.



Next a small pillow for his belly of 0.3 grams.



Now a small amount of 0.05 grams for his ear.

You want to keep this piece of wool towards the back edge of the ear so that it sits prouder like a real ear.

Finally a pillow of 0.2 grams for his head.



Take some time to make sure that they are all felted firmly to the base shape.



To smooth over the pillows I now add a flat sheet of wool that weighs 0.8 grams.

Place this over your work and place the template over the top of that.

Start to attach that sheet to your work.

Working your way all around the shapes that you have added.



Now turn it over and start to tuck all the loose edges into the back of the shape.

Finally take two pinches of Black for an eye and a nose to your Dog.



I have rolled the pinch of Black for his nose between my fingers to make a shape like a grain of rice.

Felt each end into the nose position.



Then roll another pinch into a rice grain shape for his eye.



There you have your finished Scotty dog.
