



## Alexis Round Rug Crochet Pattern

with

# MATILDA Braided Cord



### **Requirements:**

A basic knowledge of crochet

500m x 5mm MATILDA Braided Cord

8mm Crochet Hook

Stitch Markers

Yarn Needle

#### **Notes:**

Finished Size: 1m

Pattern is written in US Crochet Terms.

Rug is worked in a continuous spiral without connecting the rounds.

Increases are staggered.

#### **Abbreviations:**

**Ch** Chain

Sc Single Crochet

**Dc** Double Crochet

Rnd(s) Round(s)

Sts Stitches

( ) Work the instructions inside the brackets as many times as indicated.

## Tips:

As you are working in a continuous spiral, I suggest marking the **front** of the first stitch in every round. This will allow you to easily determine where a round starts and finishes.



Be sure to draw up **long** loops on your single crochet as per photo below.



#### **PATTERN**

#### Form a magic ring, ch 1.

Rnd 1 8 sc in magic ring [8 sts]

Rnd 2 2 sc in each sc around [16 sts]

**Rnd 3** (sc, 2 sc in next) 8 times [24 sts]

Rnd 4 (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next) 8 times [32 sts]

Rnd 5 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next, (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next) 7 times, sc in last st [40 sts]

Rnd 6 (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next) 8 times [48 sts]

Rnd 7 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next, (sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next) 7 times, sc in last 3 sts [56]

sts]

Rnd 8 (sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next) 8 times [64 sts]

Rnd 9 sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next (sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next) 7 times, sc in last 4 sts [72

sts]




Rnd 10 sc in each st around [72 sts]

Rnd 11 (sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next) 8 times [80 sts]

Rnd 12 sc in each st around [80 sts]

Rnd 13 (skip next st, dc, ch 1, dc in previous st) 40 times [120 sts] (\*refer video)

Rnd 14 sc in each st around [120 sts]





Rnd 15-19 sc in each st around [120 sts]



Rnd 20 (skip next st, dc, ch 1, dc in previous st) 60 times [180 sts]



Continue to sc around using remaining yarn.

Weave in tail.
