Debora Cardaci was born in Argentina, moving to the United States as an infant with her family and returning to her home country in 1976 at age 11.

After graduating from High School in Buenos Aires, she went on to complete her Fine Arts Degree at the P.Pueyrredon/DelaCarcova University specializing in drawing, sculpting, and painting techniques.

From 1993 to 2005, after graduating, Cardaci went on to study with international masters in Argentina, Europe, and the United States. She then began teaching Life Drawing and Sculpting classes at the University of Arts as well as giving private lessons in her Buenos Aires studio.

During this time she attended workshops and studied the work of the masters - travelling to Belgium, Austria, Germany, France, Italy, Spain, Russia, Czech Republic, the United States and Canada. She mounted solo and group shows in Buenos Aires, Italy, Uruguay and New York City.

In 2006 Cardaci immigrated to Canada where she began by producing illustrations for the International Polar Year science projects and has since gone on to mount innumerable solo and group exhibitions. A comprehensive list of her shows is available on request.

Currently Cardaci has been commissioned by the town of St. Jean Baptiste to create a life size bronze of two figures for the town square, something she has done in the past in her home country of Argentina. She continues to be a sought after instructor giving workshops across the many skill sets she possesses as well as selective private instruction.
