- Stow Pet / Child Accessories + Toys
- Stow Wastebaskets
- Sweep / Vacuum Floors
- Turn On All Lights + Replace Bulbs
- Open Shades / Blinds + Close All Windows

KITCHEN/DINING

- Remove Art From Refrigerator
- Stow All Food, Small Appliances, Pots/Pans
- Stow Cleaning Supplies
- Organize Open Shelving
- Clear Sink + Stow Drying Rack
- Wipe Counters + Tabletops
- Straighten Dining Chairs + Stools

BEDROOMS/BATHS

- Make Beds + Clear Underneath
- Put Away All Clothing + Accessories
- Clean Bathrooms + Mirrors
- Clear Counters + Tubs/Showers
- Stow Cleaning Supplies
- Close All Toilet Lids
- Hang Folded Towels

EXTERIOR

- Move Vehicles From Driveway
- Sweep Walkways
- Stow Toys + Seasonal Decor
- Stow Garden Supplies, Hoses, Trash Cans
- Straighten Outdoor Furniture
- Clean Pool + Surrounding Areas
- Trim Lawn + Keep Yard Tidy
