Incoordination, diarrhoea, liver failure

#### Oleander

Drooling, vomiting, collapse, tremors, seizures, death

Poppy Inappetance, sedation, slowed breathing and heart rate, coma

#### Star of Bethlehem

Drooling, vomiting, collapse, tremors, seizures, death

Tulip Bulbs Vomiting, diarrhoea, difficulty breathing

Vomiting, diarrhoea, drooling, tremors, seizures




#### **Karaka Berry**

Vomiting, diarrhoea, limb stiffness, seizures, death

#### **Milkweed**

Drooling, vomiting, collapse, tremors, seizures, death

Swallowed and contact irritation

#### Wisteria

Vomiting (sometimes bloody), diarrhoea, depression
