

# Poisons - Plants

Everyday plants that are in your garden that are toxic to your pets

## Aloe Vera

Vomiting, diarrhoea, depression, anorexia, tremors



## Azalea - Rhododendron

Vomiting, diarrhoea, pain, tremors, blindness, seizures, coma



## Belladonna

Elevated heart rate, respiratory failure, hallucinations



## Blue Green

Algae Vomiting, diarrhoea, black tarry stool, jaundice, seizures, coma, death



## Chrysanthemum

Vomiting, diarrhoea, inappetance



## Cherry

All parts of the plant except for the ripe fruit. Vomiting, diarrhoea, ulceration, seizures



## Daffodils

Vomiting, diarrhoea, pain, abnormal breathing, cardiac arrhythmias



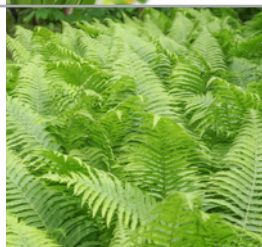
## Daphne

Ulceration, drooling, vomiting, bloody diarrhoea, coma, death



## Fern - Asparagus

Vomiting, diarrhoea, pain, dermatitis



## Fox Glove

Drooling, vomiting, collapse, tremors, seizures, death



## Geranium

Vomiting, anorexia, depression, dermatitis



## Horse Chestnut

Drooling, vomiting, dilated pupils, coma, convulsions



## Hyacinth Bulbs

Vomiting, diarrhoea, dermatitis



## Hydrangea

Lethargy, vomiting, diarrhoea
