CROCODILE SAFETY

HOW DO I STAY SAFE IN AREAS WITH SALTWATER CROCODILES?

- Do not linger at the water's edge or get into the water to retrieve a golf ball, especially in early morning or dusk.
- Be aware of surroundings especially when standing near water bodies and stay at least 2 meters away from the water's edge.
- Do not stand or play a shot with your back to the water's edge.
- Play in a group of at least two people, to always have someone able to watch out for crocodiles
- Do not feed a crocodile as this makes it associate people with food, encouraging it to approach

IF YOU ENCOUNTER A CROCODILE:

- Stay calm, back away slowly and try not to make sudden movements.
- Do not approach, provoke or feed the crocodile.
- If a crocodile heads your way, run away in a straight line (not side to side)
- Report to Panaga Club staff, who can contact Wildlife Division on the Forestry Department for further actions.
