
#1: Finance Update by Alper

As at 31st October, the Club has reported:

Total income of \$124,321 (1% decrease compared to last month).

Subscription fee portion of this income is ~\$94,324 that represent a %1 increase compared to last month.

- Total expense of \$199,343 (15% increase from last month).
- Resulting net loss of ~BND 75,022

CP queried on income outside of subscription, FM informed that:


- In terms of income from facilities, room bookings are meeting their targets

KBBCC: gentle reminder to all sections to submit their chits to club timely to record income more accurately, which is also benefical for sections budget review.


• This graph shows our cash position movement throughout months.





Additional comments from MCM:

- PMS to make better use of music facilities and improve on scheduling to reduce long waitlist

• CDC mentioned that dance classes cancelled are usually informed last minute through PDC's Facebook group with no replacement classes. PEMM has informed that email sent by section committee is also usually last minute, leading to unavoidable disappointment
