## **INFORMATION SHEET**

General Information, Parental Commitment and 1<sup>st</sup> PANAGA CUBS Code of Conduct By applying to this Section you will be agreeing to the terms detailed below: -

- 1. Cubs are the second stage in the scouting world, and are aimed at the 7-11 years age-group, and this pack is for children/dependent of Panaga Club members. Cubs participate in a range of activities including indoor and outdoor games/excursions (weather permitting), crafts, puzzles, treasure hunts, learning, adventure, etc, as well as learning about scouting. Cubs can work towards obtaining badges which when awarded are then worn on their uniform. We aim to ensure the sessions are fun and informative.
- 2. Cancellation of membership is to be **in writing** to the Panaga Club Administration Office and also with notification to us. Members who resign may not be allowed to re-apply after six months after the cancellation date.
- 3. Cancellation of membership does not entitle me to any refund, in full or pro rata rebates.
- 4. Temporary Members will be charged BND10 per meeting in addition to the Day Pass Visitor fee of BND5 per day.
- 5. Pack meetings will be held on Tuesday evenings in the Rampayoh School Hall from 6.00pm to 7.00pm term time only. Meetings that are longer than an hour will be held on Saturdays or Sundays. Programmes will be given at the beginning of each half term.
- **6.** Communications are done via Email and through the 1<sup>st</sup> Panaga Cubs Facebook Group. General information is also available on the Panaga Club website. Enquiries to be addressed to **1stpanagacubs@gmail.com**.
- 7. In addition to the uniformed leaders, we will sometimes ask parents or older children for help with activities on Cub nights or weekends. If you have an interest to share (nature, arts, sport, etc...) or can arrange a special visit for the pack, we will be delighted.
- 8. We aim to live up to the Cubs motto and ensure your child has fun while he learns and makes friends during his time with us.

- 10. We expect parents to help us as follows:
- Bring your child promptly for the start of our meetings.
- Ensure your child arrives each week wearing the appropriate uniform.
- Arrive at the School Hall at 6.00pm in order to collect your child or if they are allowed to cycle home themselves, please let us know in advance.
- Inform us in advance if your child has any disabilities, allergies or behavioural problems.
- Ensure you child brings a bottle of drinking water as some activities will be outdoor.

Ensure your child is aware that we expect ALL our Cubs to be well-behaved at all times.

### Investiture

1. New Cubs will be invested about 4 weeks of the start date with the Cub pack. We welcome families to attend the investiture. A payment of BND\$40 is to be paid before the ceremony. This payment covers cap, neckerchief, woggle, badges and certificates. There is a replacement fee for lost items.

### **Badges**

- 1. After being enrolled each Cub can work to obtain various badges which are then worn on the uniform.
- 2. Written details regarding requirements to achieve each badge will be given.
- 3. Evidence of work completed should be brought to the Cubs meeting along with the "Cub Scout Badge Requirement" form signed by parent/guardian.
- 4. Before being awarded a badge, the Cub will show his work to the Cub pack, talk about what he has done to achieve it, and answer any questions.

#### Uniform

- It is advisable to wait for a few weeks before buying the uniform, until your child has experienced Cubs and is happy to be enrolled. In the interim he/she should wear white T-Shirt with dark blue shorts/trousers (similar to Panaga School PE kit) and trainers (not Crocs/Sandals). Please note casual clothes are not allowed.
- 2. Should your child decide that he wants to join us officially, he MUST be in full uniform at the investiture ceremony. They will need **ONLY** the following:
  - Long Sleeved Blue Shirt
  - Long Dark Blue Trousers.
  - Dark Blue Socks
  - Black Shoes
  - Black Belt (not compulsory)
