INFORMATION SHEET

General Information, Parental Commitment and 1st PANAGA SCOUTS Code of Conduct By applying to this Section you will be agreeing to the terms detailed below: -

- 1. Boy Scouts are the third stage in the scouting world, and are aimed at the 11-17 years age-group, and this pack is for children/dependent of Panaga Club members. Scouts participate in a range of activities including indoor and outdoor games/excursions (weather permitting), crafts, leadership development, learning life skills, adventure, etc, as well as learning about scouting. Scouts can work towards obtaining rank advancements which when awarded are then worn on their uniform. We aim to ensure the sessions are fun and informative.
- 2. Cancellation of membership is to be **in writing** to the Panaga Club Administration Office and also with notification to us. Members who resign may not re-apply for until six months after the termination date.
- 3. Cancellation of membership does not entitle me to any refund, in full or pro rata rebates.
- 4. Temporary Members will be charged BND10 per meeting in addition to the Club's BND5 entrance fee.
- 5. Troop meetings will be held on alternate Saturdays at Panaga Club from 8.30am to 10.30am term time only. Programmes will be given at the beginning of each half term.
- **6.** Communications are done via Email and through the 1st Panaga Cubs Scout Facebook Group. General information is also available on the Panaga Club website. Enquiries to be addressed to **1stpanagascout@gmail.com**.
- 7. In addition to the uniformed leaders, we will ask parents or older children for help with activities. If you have an interest to share (nature, arts, sport, etc...) or can arrange a special visit for the troop, we will be delighted.
- 8. We aim to live up to the Scouts motto and ensure your child has fun while he learns and makes friends during his time with us.
- 9. We expect parents to help us as follows:
- Bring your child promptly for the start of our meetings.
- Ensure your child arrives wearing the appropriate uniform and bring Scout Handbook
- Inform us in advance if your child has any disabilities, allergies or behavioural problems.
- Ensure you child brings a bottle of drinking water as some activities will be outdoor.
- Parents participation is mandatory.

.....and most importantly

Ensure your child is aware that we expect ALL our Scouts to be well-behaved at all times.

Badges

- 1. After being enrolled each Scout can work to obtain various badges which are then worn on the uniform.
- 2. Written details regarding requirements to achieve each badge are in the handbook/website.
- 3. Evidence of work completed should be brought to the Scout meeting and given to Scout Master during Scout Master Review.







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Uniform

- 1. Upon acceptance to join our troop, please bring BND50 to your first meeting. This payment covers Book, Class B T-Shirt, Cap, Neckerchief, Slide, Badges and etc...
- 2. Uniforms:

Class A Uniform must be worn to all meetings unless stated otherwise. It consist of-

- Shirt with Badges
- Neckerchief & Slide
- Cap
- Military Green Shorts/Trousers
- Shoes/Trainers

Class B Uniform consists of:

- Scout T-Shirt
- Shorts
- Trainers

Scout Shirt can be tailored at local tailors.

Parades/Services

- 1. The Scout Association is an open troop concerning religion. We do not attend regular services as a pack.
- 2. However, we expect full attendance at a few important services each year as dictated by Brunei Scouts Association.

Absences

- 1. If for any reason your child is going to miss a troop meeting, please inform one of the leaders beforehand.
- 2. There is a waiting list and should your child not be able to attend troop meetings on a regular basis, his place may be offered to someone else on the waiting list.
