CHILDREN UNDER 14 YEARS OLD	<p>Children under 14 years old must be supervised and accompanied by parent or guardian (adult) at all times at Club premises and when in swimming pools or surrounding area of the pools defined by the barriers.</p>
NO OF GUESTS RECIPROCAL MEMBER MAY BRING	<p>Guest upon prior approval may accompany reciprocal members to food & beverage outlets only.</p> <p><u>Guests may not use any Club facilities including swimming pool.</u></p>
HOW ARE ACCOUNTS SETTLED	<p>By coupons to be purchased at Panaga Club or Kuala Belait Boat Club F&B outlets.</p>
DRESS CODE	<p>Members are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to the occasion being attended or the facilities being used in the Club.</p>
ALCOHOL	<p>Members are not allowed to bring or consume alcohol on Club premises.</p> <p>Catering Outlets are only serving alcohol free drinks.</p>

Golf equipment can be purchased in the Golf Shop. Members wanting to play golf should bring their handicap card. The Panaga Golf Section Committee will reserve the right at its sole discretion to refuse the use of the golf course to visitors who are not satisfying the criteria for reciprocal membership. It possesses a fleet of 470's and other dingies, a 38-foot sea going yacht (Star of Siam), sub aqua diving plus 5 power boats and 1 fishing boat. There is also a large fleet of some 12 catamarans (Hobies). These are based all year round on the KBBC facilities at Panaga beach.</p> <p>Six tennis courts plus practice courts. A tennis shop.</p> <p>Multi-purpose sports hall, which consists of six badminton courts and facilities for indoor football, netball, basket, tri-fit, dance, etc. Dancewear needs can be purchased in the Dance Shop.</p> <p>A fully equipped fitness centre for workouts etc.</p> <p>Pitches for football, hockey, rugby, tee-ball and cricket. The Scottish Community holds the yearly Highland Games on the padang.</p> <p>Bowling green.</p>
<p><u>OTHER FACILITES</u></p>	<p>A large theatre hall (Main Hall) with seating for 100 to 140 persons for a spacious modern sloping stage and sound proof projector and lighting control room. Many large functions, such as dances, amateur productions, musical soirees and concert performances are held.</p>

For your safety and enjoyment, please take note of the information and rules below:

INFORMATION

SAFETY	IS YOUR responsibility for yourself and children in your care
<u>LIFEGUARDS</u>	<u>NONE on duty</u>
POOL WARDENS	OBEY their instructions and bring any concerns to their attention

RULES

USERS	MUST shower BEFORE entering pool MUST be accompanied by an adult if under 14 years old MUST have "proper" swimwear Infants/toddlers MUST have "swim nappies" Incontinent children MUST not use main pool
WET DECK	NO running or unsupervised ball games NO footwear (except for "operational reasons")
POOL	NO throwing or pushing of people into pools NO unsupervised ball games ONLY DIVE into deep end of main pool
SLIDE	ONLY ONE child to use the slide at a time
FOOD & DRINK	NOT permitted in pool or "wet deck" area Meals only to be served at round tables

Always be conscious of and respectful to all other pool users

The "wet deck" is the tiled area surrounding the pools
