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## Child Member Agreement

1. I will sign in next to my name each time I arrive at Youth Club.
2. I will stay within the Jungle House grounds or designated space at a venue and will not leave without first informing a parent supervisor AND signing out.
3. I know that the Under 5's playground in front of the Jungle House is out-of-bounds to Panaga Youth Club members.
4. I will remove all outdoor footwear before entering the Jungle House.
5. I will always treat other children with respect and I will not bully others either physically or verbally and I will inform an adult if I see others doing this.
6. I will speak politely to parent supervisors, follow their instructions and respect their decisions.
7. I know that bad language, swearing and put-downs will not be tolerated.
8. I will treat all the equipment, fixtures and fittings in the club with care and respect.
9. I will not bring valuables to Youth Club (jewelry, i-pods, gameboys, PSP, MP3 players etc.) these items will be confiscated and I understand that any loss or damage would be my responsibility.
10. I help with cleaning up after Youth Club including putting carefully putting away equipment, sweeping and will make sure to put rubbish into the bins provided.

## Consequences for breaking the rules?

*I know that if I do not follow the Panaga Youth Club guidelines, I shall receive a black mark for each instance. Three black marks against me will result in suspension from the Panaga Youth Club for a period of one term. Any subsequent misconduct resulting in black mark will result in immediate expulsion.*
