

New Local Rules (effective 28th May 2021)

Due to the current Greens condition, PGC Committee is implementing the following Local Rules until further notice.

<u>Greens 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 16, 17</u>

Damaged areas on the abovementioned Greens are marked with white lines and classified as GUR (Ground under Repair).

If a player's ball is on the putting green and line of play/putt is interfered, the player may take free relief by placing the original ball or another ball on the spot of the nearest point of complete relief.

- The nearest point of complete relief must be either on the putting green or in the general area.
- If there is no such nearest point of complete relief, the player may still take this free relief by using the point of maximum available relief as the reference point, which must be either on the putting green or in the general area.

Temporary Green 6 and 15

Due to the un-playable conditions of Greens 6 and 15, temporary Greens will be placed for usage until conditions on the original Greens are restored.

The Committee agree to implement a Local Rule that allow the player to hole out without putting but adding one stroke to score for those holes, once the player's ball land on the temporary greens.

This will apply on normal day golf and the upcoming PGC organised tournaments until further notice.
