The PA-ADS1 is an analog audio delay device with simple stereo RCA audio input and output to resolve "lip sync" issues in audio and video systems. The PA-ADS1 is a simple and perfect solution with 16 increments to delay audio anywhere from 20ms to 340ms with a turn of a dial.
