

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PART NO. 16867

Installation Instructions:

- 1. Volant Cool Air Intake for Dodge 6.7 2008.
- 2. Disconnect negative battery cables.
- 3. Unclip MAF sensor and air temperature sensor.
- 4. Remove 10mm bolt holding the factory air box to the core support.
- 5. Loosen the clamp holding the factory air duct to air box.
- 6. Pull stock duct off of air box.
- 7. Remove factory air box by pulling up and out.
- 8. Loosen clamp on the elbow and leave the clamp on the turbo tight. Remove factory air duct from engine compartment.
- 9. Install U-nuts on factory battery box.
- 10. Place Volant Filter Box into factory position.
- 11. Tighten box down with the supplied 3/8" bolts, lock washers and washers.
- 12. Attach 4" hump hose to □ Iter adapter tighten with #064 clamp.
- 13. Remove air temp sensor from the factory air duct with the torx bit provided.
- 14. Install the temp into the upper hole on the Volant Air Duct attach with factory screw.
- 15. Remove the factory MAF from the factory air duct with the torx bit provided.
- 16. Install the MAF into lower hole on Volant Air Duct tighten with factory screw.
- 17. Attach the Voland Air Duct to the factory elbow.
- 18. Attach the Volant Air Duct to the factory elbow with a #064 clamp.
- 19. Attach Volant Ram Filter to □ Iter adapter and tighten clamp.
- 20. Attach lid to volant air box.
- 21. Clip air temp sensor and MAF back. Tighten battery cables.

WARNING: OVER TIGHTENING HARDWARE MAY ALTAR THE INTEGRITY OF THE VOLANT AIR INTAKE SYSTEM.

BEFORE ROAD TESTING

- 1. Start engine, leaving the transmission in park and securing the parking brake.
- Make sure to look and listen for any unusual noises or air leaks. Repair problems if needed.
- 3. Once completed it will be necessary to check periodically for realignment and tightening of all connections.
- Once all tests are completed, enjoy the performance of your new Volant Air Intake System.

CARE AND CLEANING

Check the cotton reusable filter periodically and remove any excessive dirt build-up by tapping the filter on the ground and brushing off the loosened dirt. Clean the filter by using Volant's Filter Recharger Kit. Volant's Filter Recharger Kit is designed to restore original air flow. Re-oil every 10,000 miles without cleaning to improve filtering in sand and dirt. Clean only when dirt is very excessive or 50,000 miles.
