FAQ'S

Always read the full instructions on the aerosol can before use.

How long does it last?

It is advisable to treat the home every 6 months.

How often should treatment be done?

As a preventative treatment should be done every 6 months. If heavy infestations occur in the home, it can be used every 2 weeks until the infestation is under control.

Is there anything else that can be done to help get rid of the fleas?

- Wash pet bedding on a high temperature 60°c
- Turn the heating up to create a humid environment for eggs to hatch into larvae
- Vacuum every day. Vacuuming not only helps remove flea eggs in the home, but it also encourages flea pupae to hatch.
- Allow pets' normal access to rooms in the house to encourage fleas out of hiding

How does it work?

Our household flea spray combines three active ingredients to treat and break the flea lifecycle to provide long term and effective flea control in your home:

- TWO FAST ACTING INSECTICIDES Pyrethrin and Permethrin provide fast and effective control of adult fleas.
- AN INSECT GROWTH REGULATOR S-methoprene is key to breaking the flea life cycle, preventing the development and growth of flea eggs and flea larvae in the home, for up to six months

Is it safe for children and other pets?

Ensure that children and animals are not in the area whilst it is being treated. Fish and exotic species in vivarium's should also be removed from the area.

How long after treatment can animals and children return to the area?

Children and animals may use the area as normal once the spray has dried and room has been well ventilated.

How many cans will I need?

One 500ml can should be enough to treat a typical family home. For treatment, the can should be held 30cm from area being treated, this will mean a 10 second burst will cover an area of one square metre.

Can the home be treated in stages?

Ideally the home should be treated in one go but if it is necessary it can be completed in several phases - upstairs / downstairs.

Do I also need to treat my pet?

Yes. We recommend that you use a veterinary recommended pet treatment on all of your pets in conjunction with the treatment of your home.

Will it control other types of pests?

Yes. It will also kill other crawling pests such as cockroaches, ants and silverfish.

How much does it cost?

It is £9.99 for a 500ml can.

Can PDSA Vet Care Ultimate Household Flea Spray be used on a human's bed mattress?

We advise not to spray human bedding due to the long period that pet owners would then be in close proximity to the spray. There is no reason to be concerned, but it is just not a necessary thing to do.

Our advice would be to:

- 1. Wash all removable bedding at a hot temperature,
- 2. Run a hot steam iron over the face of the mattress
- 3. Turn the mattress over
