* The declared percentage of spelt content on the label is referred to the Italian beer production and hygiene regulation (L 1354/62) that states that other cereals or sugar sources than malt can be used in the brewing process, but their quantity must not exceed the 40% of the wort extract. Therefore, the spelt percentage declared on the label is referred to its contribution to the wort extract and does not represent the effective percentage on the total amount of the ingredients, including water.
