Glass Plaque Installation Guide



Things you will need:

A Fine Day – preferably 2 in a row (check the forecast) Concrete or Granite foundation V60 Neutral Cure Silicone Tube and applicator end

Please follow the steps below for proper installation of your glass memorial plaque:

1. Use Methylated Spirits/rubbing alcohol or Window cleaner to clean the intended spot.

- 2. Mark with a masking tape or a pencil the exact spot where the plaque will be installed.
- 3. Place the plaque in the spot you have marked to be sure your markings are exact.

WE STRONGLY SUGGEST THE FOLLOWING METHOD USING SILICONE:

This is the preferred method.

Most plaques are not 100% flat on the back due to the nature of slumped glass. Therefore, silicone would provide the best adhesion. It is also easier to install since it doesn't set immediately.

- 1. Place the plaque where you would like it to sit and surround the space closely and neatly with masking tape
- 2. Apply a small amount of silicone on the back of your plaque.
- 3. Place your plaque within your marking tape and press it in place.
- 4. Place blue masking tape over the plaque to keep it in place for at least 30 min until silicone hardens.
- 5. After 30min use silicone to seal the space between your plaque and surface edges where it is mounted. It will also make the overall installation look better. Smoothing the area. This can sometimes be tricky, but the water and washing up liquid mixture make things much easier. Just dip your finger into the liquid (make sure it's slippery) and then, with as little pressure as possible, run your finger along the line of silicone, smoothing it out as you go.
