TASTE WITH THE WINEMAKER

"The art of blending is part of the winemaker's craft, an exercise that often proves the sum of the parts is a delicious outcome. Each year we select flavorful lots with a supple style in mind for our Treo blend. This year Petite Sirah made up the backbone, flanked by a mix of Zinfandel, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvginon, with a touch of Merlot and Malbec. The result is a wine that is rich and full of flavor. The aromas beckon for a delicious barbeque, with notes of bing cherry and pomegranate lifting from the glass. On the mouth, bold, dark bramble fruit flavors lead to plush notes of blueberry on the long, pleasant finish. The tannins are soft and easy drinking - we craft this blend to ensure the wine is accessible when you decide to open the bottle. Maybe that's why it's become so popular. Enjoy!"



2019 VINTAGE

Vintage 2019 began slightly later than expected, but nonetheless delivered superb results. Spring was marked by occasional rains and cooler temperatures, saturating the soil, and allowing fruit to mature at a steady pace. A warm Summer helped the fruit to ripen, continuing into ideal conditions throughout August and September. The warm days and cool nights of the Fall allowed gradual sugar accumulation and longer hang times, promising fruit of the highest quality with structural beauty from balanced tannin, sugar, and acid levels. Fruit was picked at its peak, promising exceptional flavor in bottle.
