Glen Carlou is situated in the Simonsberg-Paarl region of South Africa's Western Cape. Our vineyard blocks encompass a variety of slopes and aspects - each is nurtured according to its own unique potential, respecting the natural cycles of the vines.

Our 145 hectare property transferred back to local ownership when in 2016, Glen Carlou nased by a South African family consortium.

al releases of mostly single vineyard and naturally fermented es. Fruit is sourced from distinctive small blocks or vineyards, leans of contracts entered into with specific grape growers. unique attributes either from a viniculture feature or through casionally only 600 bottles of a wine are released, as quantity is restricted due to the yield.

ur viticulturist and winemaker are passionately involved in aintaining the unique terroir of our vineyards nestled on the opes of the Simonsberg Mountain. Vines in all three vineyards e drip irrigated and trained on a 5 wire Perold trellis system. anted in selected sites suited for each variety, the soils onsist of weathered granite and "koffieklip".

entle handling and absolute attention throughout the wine aking process ensured the wine was kept as natural as ossible. Distinct blackcurrant and liquorice, with characteristic ell pepper notes mingle with chocolate and sweet berry avours. The components were fermented naturally in small pen top barrels and left on skins for 30 days. Only the ee-draining juice went into French Oak barriques, matured for 8 months. Our philosophy for Collection is one of minimal tervention during the winemaking process, as the wines are ncouraged to develop at their own pace.

full and complex. Vibrant red fruit and cassis from the Cabernet auvignon combined with hints of Cabernet Franc's tobacco leaf nd bell pepper and a drop of Merlot's plum and vanilla ndertones. Explosive and evolving aromas of ripe black berries, ather and pencil shavings are followed by hints of cedar wood nd cassis. The palate is brimming with dark fruit and peppermint chocolate, alongside of soft tannins and a velvety finish. A wine of great pedigree that will reward cellaring." (Johnnie Calitz - Winemaker)
