**VINTAGE NOTES**

The season was characterized by cool spring months with below the minimum and maximum temperatures of the previous season. The summer was warm and dry, very similar to the 2012 vintage but with slightly higher maximum average temperatures. Rainfall concentrated mainly during winter months. The clusters and grains were selected and transported gravitationally into the stainless steel tanks.

**VINEYARD ALTITUDE:** 770 m.a.s

**SOIL TEXTURE:** Colluvial origin, clay loam.

**CLIMATE:** Sub humid Mediterranean with huge influence of the Andes Mountain.

**THERMAL OSCILLATION:** Between 18 and 22°C

**CONDUCTION SYSTEM:** Espalier.

**PRUNING:** Double Guyot

**YIELD:** 6.500 kg/ha

**COOL MACERATION:** 4 days.

**ALCOHOLIC FERMENTATION:** 6 days

**POST FERMENTATIVE MACERATION:** 10 days

**AGEING:** 12 months in French oak barrels.
