Chacra La Papay is the name of our vineyard and therefore this line of wines directly offers the clear and elegant aromatic expression of our wines, with smooth and balanced tannins that provide the right structure.

Malma is a word of the ancient inhabitants from this part of Patagonia that means pride. Pride for the road travelled and for everything that has been undertaken.

Owned by the Viola family, Bodega Malma, a viticultural pioneer in San Patricio del Chañar, honours its name with the pride we have for the way our wines express the terroir and the care we put into them.



VINEYARD

Region: San Patricio Del Chañar - Argentine Patagonia.

Latitud: 39° S.

Climate: Wide thermal amplitude. Low atmospheric humidity; constant winds and low precipitation.

Soil: Loose sandy aeolian topsoil of 20 cm, somewhat gravelly with good drainage and fairly large rocks at depth. The soils have very low organic content.

VINIFICATION

Fermentation: Traditional, 14 days. Temperature controlled at 26°-28°C.

Ageing: Brief barrel-ageing of 20% of the volume.

TASTING NOTES

Color: Attractive cherry red.

Nose: Expressive, with notes of red fruit such as strawberries and cherries standing out.

Mouth: Fresh, round and balanced. A wine with defined flavours, lively and easy to drink.
