

A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO BE A PART OF OUR DISTILLERY'S WHISKY HISTORY.

To mark the opening of our new whisky distillery we are releasing a select amount of casks for sale to the public. This is the first time we have made casks available for sale since 2017 and is a unique opportunity to be part of an important moment in the history of our distillery.

Since the release of our first whisky in 2017 Cotswolds Single Malt has established itself as one of the most exciting whiskies within the dynamic World Whisky category. As the leading English whisky, we have cemented our position for quality winning over 100 prestigious awards globally.

Most recently we appeared in the list of 'World's Most Admired Whisky Brands', collated by Drinks International, for the second year running where we sat alongside some of the world's most respected and long established whisky brands.

Our new distillery marks an important moment in our journey as we increase our whisky production to meet global demand. Crucially, the new distillery has been designed to mirror the rich and fruity new make spirit for which we have become synonymous with - it's the same award-winning spirit, now allowing us to embark on a limited number of cask sales.







OUR COTSWOLDS CASK OFFER.

We pride ourselves on using the best oak to house our Cotswolds new make spirit. From innovative casks from Portugal through to carefully sourced barrels from Kentucky and the finest Spanish sherry casks.

For Cotswolds ownership casks we are offering the following cask types:

- 200 litre first fill Bourbon casks. These premium American oak barrels are ideal for ageing whisky and impart delicious notes of vanilla, honey and tropical fruits.
- 225 litre ex-red wine STR (shaved, toasted, recharred) casks. A signature cask of our distillery, these highly active casks give a rich and intense maturation, offering strong notes of toffee, chocolate and red fruits, as well as a beautiful, deep colour.
- 250 litre sherry casks. The finest American and Spanish oak hogsheads, some of which have been seasoned with dry Oloroso sherry and others with sweet Pedro Ximénez. Full of dried fruits, chocolate and a touch of spice.

The amount of time you age your Cotswolds Single Malt beyond the mandatory three years is up to you, putting you in charge of the final flavour. The different barrel types will mature at different rates and the nose, palette and finish will change over time. Our team of distillers will be on hand to offer any advice you require on the process.

We will provide you with a commemorative certificate with the number of your cask. The cask will be stored here in the Cotswolds in one of our bonded warehouses, including storage for up to 10 years.

OPTIONS & FLEXIBILITY.

We offer two different options to suit your needs:

- Full bottling of your cask for you, where you pay the duty,
 VAT and bottling charges at the time of bottling.
- Bottling 1/3 of your cask at no additional charge to you, in which case we retain 2/3 of the barrel.





PRICING EXAMPLE.

On this page we have included a table showing an estimation of costs. There are many external factors that go into the maturation of a cask and so the calculations relating to bottling are purely examples and are to be taken as a guide only.

The table is based on 5 years of ageing, the product being bottled at a cask strength of 59% ABV - if you decide to vary the ABV this will change the duty, number of bottles and thus the bottling/packaging cost.

Duty & VAT correct at time of writing (September 2023) but are subject to change by HMRC with no notice.

Your spirit will evaporate at approximately 1-3% per annum – the 'Angel's Share' as it is known! Casks draw a certain amount of spirit into the wood in the first year (roughly 5%) each subsequent year also sees slight evaporation. This differs according to the cask type.

Cask owners are offered an exclusive opportunity each year to experience a tour as we arrange for a sample from your cask to be drawn so that you can see how it is maturing.

If you are unable to visit us for the annual tasting, we will gladly draw samples on request and hold them here, at the Cotswolds Distillery, until such time as you can make a trip to the Cotswolds to appraise your cask's progress.

Your cask's journey is a unique and exciting one, and we are here to ensure you are a part of it, every step of the way.

BECOMING A COTSWOLDS DISTILLERY CASK OWNER.

The process to become a Cotswolds cask owner is very easy.

Once payment is complete we will advise you of the filling date, which you are welcome to attend if able, alternatively we will photograph the cask being filled. You are welcome to sign the cask.

Please note we can only fill a limited number of private casks. every month. Filling dates will be proposed once payment has been received.

14 PRIVATE CASK OWNERSHIP

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The certificate of cask ownership and these Terms and Conditions comprise the contract of sale for the purchase of new make spirit between The Cotswold Distilling Company Limited, a company registered in England under number 08561633, whose registered office is:
Phillip's Field Whichford Road, Stourton, Shipston-on-Stour, Warwickshire CV36 5EX, United Kingdom.

hereinafter referred to as the Supplier, CDC, our, us and we) and a Customer (also referred to as you or your, purchaser and owner).

- 2. The casks are only available for purchase by individuals or small groups. We require a single point of contact who will be the legal owner
 - e cask. Ownership can be transferred to another, single named owner
 - 3. Payment is due before the cask is filled and bottling costs will be required prior to bottling.
 - 4. The wooden cask remains the property of Cotswolds Distillery.
 - Final bottle volumes will depend on cask type, age and the ABV that the whisky is finally bottled at.
 - **6.** Up to 10 years' storage and insurance charges are included in the purchase price.
 - 7. Casks are stored with other Cotswolds Distillery stock at one of our bonded warehouses in the Cotswolds.
 - 8. It is the responsibility of the cask owner to advise the company of any changes of address or ownership in writing.
- **9.** You will be entitled to an annual sample of your spirit during the storage period. Upon request, we will take one 100ml duty paid sample per year which we will pass to you. Sampling directly from the cask is not permitted under any circumstances.
 - 10. The whisky cask is purchased in an individual capacity for own use, not for resale to an individual or bottler.
 - 11. Pricing is subject to UK duty and VAT which is subject to change by HMRC with no notice.
- 12. Bottling will be carried out by Cotswolds Distillery at the prevailing cost at the time of bottling. The cask must be bottled in its entirety.

 We require a minimum of 90 days' notice of the owner's intention to bottle their cask. On completion of bottling we can deliver at the
 - prevailing rate to a UK address, or the cask owner can arrange for collection of the bottles
- 13. Cotswolds Distillery and all associated logos, designs and devices are the property of the Cotswolds Distilling Company Limited.
- 14. For UK taxpayers, UK Capital Gains Tax is not applicable as whisky is regarded as a 'tangible', 'movable' and 'wasting asset'.
- Whisky purchased in cask for personal use, as gifts for family, godchildren and friends, etc would therefore be exempt.
- 15. At the conclusion of the sale the liquid becomes the property of the customer and is held in bond and insured on their behalf at no extra charge.
