The person who **receives** the cattle must ensure that the transfer is recorded on the NLIS Database. If cattle are bought or sold through a saleyard, or sold to an abattoir, the saleyard or abattoir notifies the database. If you buy cattle privately you, or someone acting on your behalf, must notify the database.

Before you submit a cattle transfer, you must know the:

- NLISIDs (printed on the tags) or RFIDs (electronic chips inside tags)
- the PICs that the cattle moved from and to
- the NVD/Waybill number (if applicable)
- the date the cattle moved

After you submit any transaction, check the Upload status:

- Note the Upload ID (Receipt) supplied by the database for your transaction
- Run the View my transaction history report for the appropriate period
- Check that the Upload status for your transaction is <u>COMPLETE</u>

Leave a space after the first three numbers

You can use this method to move cattle **onto** or **off** a property. If cattle die on-farm, producers, feedlots and third parties use the **Cattle that have died on property** option to move those tags **off** the PIC.

An agent recording dead cattle for a producer or feedlot uses the **Cattle moved off my property** option and types **DECEASED** in the Destination PIC field to move those tags **off** the PIC.

Devices transferred to the 'DECEASED PIC' are not shown on current holdings reports, which makes it is easier to reconcile cattle on the property with tags registered to that property on the database.

Transfers onto the property

Enter details in the compulsory* fields:

- Type or paste in the NLISIDs e.g. NI140229QCY00621 or RFIDs e.g. 951 000000041557
- Enter the PIC the cattle came from as the source PIC
- Select your PIC as the destination PIC
- Type the NVD/Waybill number (if applicable)
- Select the **date** the cattle moved



Transfers off the property

Enter details in the compulsory* fields:

- Type or paste in the NLISIDs or RFIDs
- Select your PIC as the source PIC
- Enter the destination PIC the cattle moved to
- Type the **NVD/Waybill** number (if applicable)
- Select the date the cattle moved



3 Follow the prompts to **confirm the details** and **>** Send the information to the database.

You can use this method to move cattle **onto** or **off** a property. Whether you move cattle onto or off a PIC, the format of the file is the same. If the file is not created automatically by your reader software, you can use Excel or Notepad to create a file to upload to the database.

Create a file to upload

Open a file on your computer. Enter the details for each animal in **one** line (see examples below).

Save the file on your computer with a meaningful **file name** and as the correct **file type**.

An **Excel** file to transfer three animals between PICs looks like the example below. The **compulsory** fields are shaded black. If there is no **NVD/Waybill**, leave the column empty. **Leave a space** after the first three numbers of RFIDs e.g. **982** 000029746236

In **Notepad** or **Wordpad**, use commas to separate the fields. When you finish typing information for the first animal, press **Enter** to start a new line for the next animal. If there is no **NVD/Waybill**, a text file looks like the example below.

You can use this method to view a list of cattle on the property, and tick the tags to transfer **off**. The person who **receives** the cattle normally notifies the database, but if you sell cattle privately, you may transfer the cattle **off** your PIC and **onto** the buyer's PIC. If the buyer also tries to record the transfer, the database automatically notifies the relevant parties that the animals are already on the buyer's PIC.
