<i>Zhu Ru</i>	Transform Phlegm
<i>Fu Ling</i>	Drain Damp
<i>Shi Jue Ming</i>	Clear Liver Heat
<i>Chen Pi</i>	Move Qi, Transform Phlegm
<i>Gou Teng</i>	Extinguish Internal Wind, Clear Liver Heat
<i>Hai Zao</i>	Transform Phlegm, Drain Water, Reduce Swelling
<i>Kun Bu</i>	Transform Phlegm, Drain Water, Reduce Swelling
<i>Shi Chang Pu</i>	Open the Orifice, Eliminate Damp
<i>Zhi Shi</i>	Move Qi
<i>Tian Nan Xing</i>	Transform Phlegm
<i>Dang Shen</i>	Tonify Qi
<i>Gan Cao</i>	Harmonize
<i>Gan Jiang</i>	Harmonize

200 Teapill	canine, feline	1-2 pills per 10 lbs bw; bid
Regular Powder 200g	canine, feline	0.5g per 10 to 20 lbs bw; bid
	equine	10 to 20g; bid
Concentrated 90g	canine, feline	½ to 1 small scoop per 10 to 20 lbs bw; bid
	equine	2½ large scoops (3g); bid
Conc. Capsule 100-0.5g	canine, feline	1 capsule per 20 to 40 lbs bw; bid
Conc. Capsule 50-0.2g	canine, feline	1 capsule for small dog/cat<10 lbs; sid

lb=pound; bw=body weight; bid=twice daily; sid=once daily
