

4 PK PACIFIERS WITH STERILIZER CASES

Avima pacifiers are designed with an orthodontic shape silicone nipple to help promote natural oral development!

All Avima products are made to the highest safety standards and are free of BPA, PVC, phthalates and polycarbonate.

Pacifier Directions for Use:

- Before each use, sterilize in boiling water for 5 minutes.
- Allow to cool and squeeze the nipple to remove any water left inside.
- Check the temperature of the pacifier before use.
- Wash thoroughly with warm soapy water and rinse before each use.
- For safety and hygiene, we recommend replacing pacifiers after 4 weeks of use.

All Avima pacifiers were tested to ensure that they can be effectively sterilized in all leading makes of standard steam sterilizers and dishwashers.

Pacifier Warnings:

- Before each use, carefully inspect the nipple by pulling in all directions. If there are any signs of damage or weakness (for example from biting), discontinue use immediately.
- Do not clean with aggressive cleaning agents. This could damage the pacifier.
- Never dip the nipple in sweet substances or medicine as this may cause tooth decay.
- Do not attempt to take the pacifier apart.
- Do not leave the pacifier in direct sunlight or extreme heat as this could weaken the silicone nipple.
- Only use Avima pacifier holders or other brands tested to EN 12586 standards. Never attach other ribbons or straps to the pacifier, your child can be strangled.

If pacifier becomes lodged in your babies mouth, do not panic, It can not be swallowed and is designed to cope with such an event. Remove as gently as possible.

Sterilizer Case Directions for Use:

These cases can be used to sterilize your pacifiers in a microwave, or as a convenient storage case.

- Before use, remove the plastic white holder and throw away.
- Fill water up to the line and place the pacifiers inside with the nipples facing down.
- Close box and heat in microwave on high 90 to 120 seconds.
- Carefully remove the case from microwave and allow to cool for at least 5 minutes. CAUTION: The case, water and pacifiers may still be hot after the cooling period.
- Open box and drain residual water. Leave pacifiers to dry in a slightly open case.

Sterilizer Case Warnings:

- Please ensure the case is completely clean with no dirt, soap or food residue before using in the microwave. If not, the case can melt and cause damage.
- Do not leave case unattended while in the microwave.
- Improper time or water level can damage microwave.
- Check the temperature of the pacifier before use.
- Keep case away from children.
